## Page 1 Book of Genesis Chapter 15

- 01\_GEN\_15\_01 After these things the word of the LORD came unto Abram in a vision, saying, Fear not, Abram: I [am] thy shield, [and] thy exceeding great reward.
- 01\_GEN\_15\_02 And Abram said, Lord GOD, what wilt thou give me, seeing I go childless, and the steward of my house [is] this Eliezer of Damascus?
- $01\_GEN\_15\_03 \ And \ Abram \ said, Behold, \ to \ me \ thou \ hast \ given \ no \ seed: \ and, \ lo, \ one \ born \ in \ my \ house \ is \ mine \ heir.$
- 01\_GEN\_15\_04 And, behold, the word of the LORD [came] unto him, saying, This shall not be thine heir; but he that shall come forth out of thine own bowels shall be thine heir.
- 01\_GEN\_15\_05 And he brought him forth abroad, and said, Look now toward heaven, and tell the stars, if thou be able to number them: and he said unto him, So shall thy seed be.
- 01\_GEN\_15\_06 And he believed in the LORD; and he counted it to him for righteousness.
- 01\_GEN\_15\_07 And he said unto him, I [am] the LORD that brought thee out of Ur of the Chaldees, to give thee this land to inherit it.
- $01\_GEN\_15\_08 \ And \ he \ said, Lord \ GOD, \ whereby \ shall \ I \ know \ that \ I \ shall \ inherit \ it?$
- 01\_GEN\_15\_09 And he said unto him, Take me an heifer of three years old, and a she goat of three years old, and a ram of three years old, and a turtledove, and a young pigeon.
- 01\_GEN\_15\_10 And he took unto him all these, and divided them in the midst, and laid each piece one against another: but the birds divided he not.
- 01\_GEN\_15\_11 And when the fowls came down upon the carcases, Abram drove them away.
- 01\_GEN\_15\_12 And when the sun was going down, a deep sleep fell upon Abram; and, lo, an horror of great darkness fell upon him.
- 01\_GEN\_15\_13 And he said unto Abram, Know of a surety that thy seed shall be a stranger in a land [that is] not theirs, and shall serve them; and they shall afflict them four hundred years;
- 01\_GEN\_15\_14 And also that nation, whom they shall serve, will I judge: and afterward shall they come out with great substance.
- 01\_GEN\_15\_15 And thou shalt go to thy fathers in peace; thou shalt be buried in a good old age.
- 01\_GEN\_15\_16 But in the fourth generation they shall come hither again: for the iniquity of the Amorites [is] not yet full.
- 01\_GEN\_15\_17 And it came to pass, that, when the sun went down, and it was dark, behold a smoking furnace, and a burning lamp that passed between those pieces.
- 01\_GEN\_15\_18 In the same day the LORD made a covenant with Abram, saying, Unto thy seed have I given this land, from the river of Egypt unto the great river, the river Euphrates:
- 01\_GEN\_15\_19 The Kenites, and the Kenizzites, and the Kadmonites,
- 01\_GEN\_15\_20 And the Hittites, and the Perizzites, and the Rephaims,
- 01\_GEN\_15\_21 And the Amorites, and the Canaanites, and the Girgashites, and the Jebusites.
