## Page 1 Book of Genesis Chapter 28

- 01\_GEN\_28\_01 And Isaac called Jacob, and blessed him, and charged him, and said unto him, Thou shalt not take a wife of the daughters of Canaan.
- 01\_GEN\_28\_02 Arise, go to Padanaram, to the house of Bethuel thy mother's father; and take thee a wife from thence of the daughters of Laban thy mother's brother.
- 01\_GEN\_28\_03 And God Almighty bless thee, and make thee fruitful, and multiply thee, that thou mayest be a multitude of people;
- 01\_GEN\_28\_04 And give thee the blessing of Abraham, to thee, and to thy seed with thee; that thou mayest inherit the land wherein thou art a stranger, which God gave unto Abraham.
- 01\_GEN\_28\_05 And Isaac sent away Jacob: and he went to Padanaram unto Laban, son of Bethuel the Syrian, the brother of Rebekah, Jacob's and Esau's mother.
- 01\_GEN\_28\_06 When Esau saw that Isaac had blessed Jacob, and sent him away to Padanaram, to take him a wife from thence; and that as he blessed him he gave him a charge, saying, Thou shalt not take a wife of the daughters of Canaan:
- 01 GEN 28 07 And that Jacob obeyed his father and his mother, and was gone to Padanaram;
- 01\_GEN\_28\_08 And Esau seeing that the daughters of Canaan pleased not Isaac his father;
- 01\_GEN\_28\_09 Then went Esau unto Ishmael, and took unto the wives which he had Mahalath the daughter of Ishmael Abraham's son, the sister of Nebajoth, to be his wife.
- 01\_GEN\_28\_10 And Jacob went out from Beersheba, and went toward Haran.
- 01\_GEN\_28\_11 And he lighted upon a certain place, and tarried there all night, because the sun was set; and he took of the stones of that place, and put [them for] his pillows, and lay down in that place to sleep.
- 01\_GEN\_28\_12 And he dreamed, and behold a ladder set up on the earth, and the top of it reached to heaven: and behold the angels of God ascending and descending on it.
- 01 GEN 28 13 And, behold, the LORD stood above it, and said, I [am] the LORD God of Abraham thy father, and the God of Isaac; the land whereon thou liest, to thee will I give it, and to thy seed;
- 01\_GEN\_28\_14 And thy seed shall be as the dust of the earth, and thou shalt spread abroad to the west, and to the east, and to the south: and in the south: and in they seed shall all the families of the earth be blessed.
- 01\_GEN\_28\_15 And, behold, I [am] with thee, and will keep thee in all [places] whither thou goest, and will bring thee again into this land; for I will not leave thee, until I have done [that] which I have spoken to thee of.
- 01\_GEN\_28\_16 And Jacob awaked out of his sleep, and he said, Surely the LORD is in this place; and I knew [it] not.
- 01\_GEN\_28\_17 And he was afraid, and said, How dreadful [is] this place! this [is] none other but the house of God, and this [is] the gate of heaven.
- 01\_GEN\_28\_18 And Jacob rose up early in the morning, and took the stone that he had put [for] his pillows, and set it up [for] a pillar, and poured oil upon the top of it.
- 01\_GEN\_28\_19 And he called the name of that place Bethel: but the name of that city [was called] Luz at the first.
- 01\_GEN\_28\_20 And Jacob vowed a vow, saying. If God will be with me, and will keep me in this way that I go, and will give me bread to eat, and raiment to put on,
- 01\_GEN\_28\_21 So that I come again to my father's house in peace; then shall the LORD be my God:
- 01\_GEN\_28\_22 And this stone, which I have set [for] a pillar, shall be God's house: and of all that thou shalt give me I will surely give the tenth unto thee.
