**Book of Deuteronomy Chapter 27**

05\_DEU\_27\_01 And Moses with the elders of Israel commanded the people, saying, Keep all the commandments which I command you this day.

05\_DEU\_27\_02 And it shall be on the day when ye shall pass over Jordan unto the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, that thou shalt set thee up great stones, and plaster them with plaster:

05\_DEU\_27\_03 And thou shalt write upon them all the words of this law, when thou art passed over, that thou mayest go in unto the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, a land that floweth with milk and honey; as the LORD God of thy fathers hath promised thee.

05\_DEU\_27\_04 Therefore it shall be when ye be gone over Jordan, [that] ye shall set up these stones, which I command you this day, in mount Ebal, and thou shalt plaster them with plaster.

05\_DEU\_27\_05 And there shalt thou build an altar unto the LORD thy God, an altar of stones: thou shalt not lift up [any] iron [tool] upon them.

05\_DEU\_27\_06 Thou shalt build the altar of the LORD thy God of whole stones: and thou shalt offer burnt offerings thereon unto the LORD thy God:

05\_DEU\_27\_07 And thou shalt offer peace offerings, and shalt eat there, and rejoice before the LORD thy God.

05\_DEU\_27\_08 And thou shalt write upon the stones all the words of this law very plainly.

05\_DEU\_27\_09 And Moses and the priests the Levites spake unto all Israel, saying, Take heed, and hearken, O Israel; this day thou art become the people of the LORD thy God.

05\_DEU\_27\_10 Thou shalt therefore obey the voice of the LORD thy God, and do his commandments and his statutes, which I command thee this day.

05\_DEU\_27\_11 And Moses charged the people the same day, saying,

05\_DEU\_27\_12 These shall stand upon mount Gerizim to bless the people, when ye are come over Jordan; Simeon, and Levi, and Judah, and Issachar, and Joseph, and Benjamin:

05\_DEU\_27\_13 And these shall stand upon mount Ebal to curse; Reuben, Gad, and Asher, and Zebulun, Dan, and Naphtali.

05\_DEU\_27\_14 And the Levites shall speak, and say unto all the men of Israel with a loud voice,

05\_DEU\_27\_15 Cursed [be] the man that maketh [any] graven or molten image, an abomination unto the LORD, the work of the hands of the craftsman, and putteth [it] in [a] secret [place]. And all the people shall answer and say, Amen.

05\_DEU\_27\_16 Cursed [be] he that setteth light by his father or his mother. And all the people shall say, Amen.

05\_DEU\_27\_17 Cursed [be] he that removeth his neighbour's landmark. And all the people shall say, Amen.

05\_DEU\_27\_18 Cursed [be] he that maketh the blind to wander out of the way. And all the people shall say, Amen.

05\_DEU\_27\_19 Cursed [be] he that perverteth the judgment of the stranger, fatherless, and widow. And all the people shall say, Amen.

05\_DEU\_27\_20 Cursed [be] he that lieth with his father's wife; because he uncovereth his father's skirt. And all the people shall say, Amen.

05\_DEU\_27\_21 Cursed [be] he that lieth with any manner of beast. And all the people shall say, Amen.

05\_DEU\_27\_22 Cursed [be] he that lieth with his sister, the daughter of his father, or the daughter of his mother. And all the people shall say, Amen.

05\_DEU\_27\_23 Cursed [be] he that lieth with his mother in law. And all the people shall say, Amen.

05\_DEU\_27\_24 Cursed [be] he that smiteth his neighbour secretly. And all the people shall say, Amen.

05\_DEU\_27\_25 Cursed [be] he that taketh reward to slay an innocent person. And all the people shall say, Amen.

05\_DEU\_27\_26 Cursed [be] he that confirmeth not [all] the words of this law to do them. And all the people shall say, Amen.
