**Book of 1st Kings Chapter 15**

11\_1KI\_15\_01 Now in the eighteenth year of king Jeroboam the son of Nebat reigned Abijam over Judah.

11\_1KI\_15\_02 Three years reigned he in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Maachah, the daughter of Abishalom.

11\_1KI\_15\_03 And he walked in all the sins of his father, which he had done before him: and his heart was not perfect with the LORD his God, as the heart of David his father.

11\_1KI\_15\_04 Nevertheless for David's sake did the LORD his God give him a lamp in Jerusalem, to set up his son after him, and to establish Jerusalem:

11\_1KI\_15\_05 Because David did [that which was] right in the eyes of the LORD, and turned not aside from any [thing] that he commanded him all the days of his life, save only in the matter of Uriah the Hittite.

11\_1KI\_15\_06 And there was war between Rehoboam and Jeroboam all the days of his life.

11\_1KI\_15\_07 Now the rest of the acts of Abijam, and all that he did, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah? And there was war between Abijam and Jeroboam.

11\_1KI\_15\_08 And Abijam slept with his fathers; and they buried him in the city of David: and Asa his son reigned in his stead.

11\_1KI\_15\_09 And in the twentieth year of Jeroboam king of Israel reigned Asa over Judah.

11\_1KI\_15\_10 And forty and one years reigned he in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Maachah, the daughter of Abishalom.

11\_1KI\_15\_11 And Asa did [that which was] right in the eyes of the LORD, as [did] David his father.

11\_1KI\_15\_12 And he took away the sodomites out of the land, and removed all the idols that his fathers had made.

11\_1KI\_15\_13 And also Maachah his mother, even her he removed from [being] queen, because she had made an idol in a grove; and Asa destroyed her idol, and burnt [it] by the brook Kidron.

11\_1KI\_15\_14 But the high places were not removed: nevertheless Asa's heart was perfect with the LORD all his days.

11\_1KI\_15\_15 And he brought in the things which his father had dedicated, and the things which himself had dedicated, into the house of the LORD, silver, and gold, and vessels.

11\_1KI\_15\_16 And there was war between Asa and Baasha king of Israel all their days.

11\_1KI\_15\_17 And Baasha king of Israel went up against Judah, and built Ramah, that he might not suffer any to go out or come in to Asa king of Judah.

11\_1KI\_15\_18 Then Asa took all the silver and the gold [that were] left in the treasures of the house of the LORD, and the treasures of the king's house, and delivered them into the hand of his servants: and king Asa sent them to Benhadad, the son of Tabrimon, the son of Hezion, king of Syria, that dwelt at Damascus, saying,

11\_1KI\_15\_19 [There is] a league between me and thee, [and] between my father and thy father: behold, I have sent unto thee a present of silver and gold; come and break thy league with Baasha king of Israel, that he may depart from me.

11\_1KI\_15\_20 So Benhadad hearkened unto king Asa, and sent the captains of the hosts which he had against the cities of Israel, and smote Ijon, and Dan, and Abelbethmaachah, and all Cinneroth, with all the land of Naphtali.

11\_1KI\_15\_21 And it came to pass, when Baasha heard [thereof], that he left off building of Ramah, and dwelt in Tirzah.

11\_1KI\_15\_22 Then king Asa made a proclamation throughout all Judah; none [was] exempted: and they took away the stones of Ramah, and the timber thereof, wherewith Baasha had builded; and king Asa built with them Geba of Benjamin, and Mizpah.

11\_1KI\_15\_23 The rest of all the acts of Asa, and all his might, and all that he did, and the cities which he built, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah? Nevertheless in the time of his old age he was diseased in his feet.

11\_1KI\_15\_24 And Asa slept with his fathers, and was buried with his fathers in the city of David his father: and Jehoshaphat his son reigned in his stead.

11\_1KI\_15\_25 And Nadab the son of Jeroboam began to reign over Israel in the second year of Asa king of Judah, and reigned over Israel two years.

11\_1KI\_15\_26 And he did evil in the sight of the LORD, and walked in the way of his father, and in his sin wherewith he made Israel to sin.

11\_1KI\_15\_27 And Baasha the son of Ahijah, of the house of Issachar, conspired against him; and Baasha smote him at Gibbethon, which [belonged] to the Philistines; for Nadab and all Israel laid siege to Gibbethon.

11\_1KI\_15\_28 Even in the third year of Asa king of Judah did Baasha slay him, and reigned in his stead.

11\_1KI\_15\_29 And it came to pass, when he reigned, [that] he smote all the house of Jeroboam; he left not to Jeroboam any that breathed, until he had destroyed him, according unto the saying of the LORD, which he spake by his servant Ahijah the Shilonite:

11\_1KI\_15\_30 Because of the sins of Jeroboam which he sinned, and which he made Israel sin, by his provocation wherewith he provoked the LORD God of Israel to anger.

11\_1KI\_15\_31 Now the rest of the acts of Nadab, and all that he did, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Israel?

11\_1KI\_15\_32 And there was war between Asa and Baasha king of Israel all their days.

11\_1KI\_15\_33 In the third year of Asa king of Judah began Baasha the son of Ahijah to reign over all Israel in Tirzah, twenty and four years.

11\_1KI\_15\_34 And he did evil in the sight of the LORD, and walked in the way of Jeroboam, and in his sin wherewith he made Israel to sin.
