## **Book of 1st Chronicles Chapter 26**

- 13\_1CH\_26\_01 Concerning the divisions of the porters: Of the Korhites [was] Meshelemiah the son of Kore, of the sons of Asaph.
- 13\_1CH\_26\_02 And the sons of Meshelemiah [were], Zechariah the firstborn, Jediael the second, Zebadiah the third, Jathniel the fourth,
- 13\_1CH\_26\_03 Elam the fifth, Jehohanan the sixth, Elioenai the seventh.
- 13\_1CH\_26\_04 Moreover the sons of Obededom [were], Shemaiah the firstborn, Jehozabad the second, Joah the third, and Sacar the fourth, and Nethaneel the fifth,
- 13 1CH 26 05 Ammiel the sixth, Issachar the seventh, Peulthai the eighth: for God blessed him.
- 13\_1CH\_26\_06 Also unto Shemaiah his son were sons born, that ruled throughout the house of their father: for they [were] mighty men of valour.
- 13\_1CH\_26\_07 The sons of Shemaiah; Othni, and Rephael, and Obed, Elzabad, whose brethren [were] strong men, Elihu, and Semachiah.
- 13\_1CH\_26\_08 All these of the sons of Obededom: they and their sons and their brethren, able men for strength for the service, [were] threescore and two of Obededom.
- 13\_1CH\_26\_09 And Meshelemiah had sons and brethren, strong men, eighteen.
- 13\_1CH\_26\_10 Also Hosah, of the children of Merari, had sons; Simri the chief, [for [though] he was not the firstborn, yet his father made him the chief;]
- 13\_1CH\_26\_11 Hilkiah the second, Tebaliah the third, Zechariah the fourth: all the sons and brethren of Hosah [were] thirteen.
- 13\_1CH\_26\_12 Among these [were] the divisions of the porters, [even] among the chief men, [having] wards one against another, to minister in the house of the LORD.
- 13\_1CH\_26\_13 And they cast lots, as well the small as the great, according to the house of their fathers, for every gate.
- 13\_1CH\_26\_14 And the lot eastward fell to Shelemiah. Then for Zechariah his son, a wise counsellor, they cast lots; and his lot came out northward.
- 13\_1CH\_26\_15 To Obededom southward; and to his sons the house of Asuppim.
- 13 1CH 26 16 To Shuppim and Hosah [the lot came forth] westward, with the gate Shallecheth, by the causeway of the going up, ward against ward.
- 13\_1CH\_26\_17 Eastward [were] six Levites, northward four a day, southward four a day, and toward Asuppim two [and] two.
- 13\_1CH\_26\_18 At Parbar westward, four at the causeway, [and] two at Parbar.
- 13\_1CH\_26\_19 These [are] the divisions of the porters among the sons of Kore, and among the sons of Merari.
- 13\_1CH\_26\_20 And of the Levites, Ahijah [was] over the treasures of the house of God, and over the treasures of the dedicated things
- 13 1CH 26 21 [As concerning] the sons of Laadan; the sons of the Gershonite Laadan, chief fathers, [even] of Laadan the Gershonite, [were] Jehieli
- 13\_1CH\_26\_22 The sons of Jehieli; Zetham, and Joel his brother, [which were] over the treasures of the house of the LORD.
- 13\_1CH\_26\_23 Of the Amramites, [and] the Izharites, the Hebronites, [and] the Uzzielites:
- 13\_1CH\_26\_24 And Shebuel the son of Gershom, the son of Moses, [was] ruler of the treasures.
- 13\_1CH\_26\_25 And his brethren by Eliezer; Rehabiah his son, and Jeshaiah his son, and Joram his son, and Zichri his son, and Shelomith his son.
- 13\_1CH\_26\_26 Which Shelomith and his brethren [were] over all the treasures of the dedicated things, which David the king, and the chief fathers, the captains over thousands and hundreds, and the captains of the host, had dedicated.
- 13\_1CH\_26\_27 Out of the spoils won in battles did they dedicate to maintain the house of the LORD.
- 13\_1CH\_26\_28 And all that Samuel the seer, and Saul the son of Kish, and Abner the son of Ner, and Joab the son of Zeruiah, had dedicated; [and] whosoever had dedicated [any thing, it was] under the hand of Shelomith, and of his brethren.
- 13\_1CH\_26\_29 Of the Izharites, Chenaniah and his sons [were] for the outward business over Israel, for officers and judges.
- 13\_1CH\_26\_30 [And] of the Hebronites, Hashabiah and his brethren, men of valour, a thousand and seven hundred, [were] officers among them of Israel on this side Jordan westward in all the business of the LORD, and in the service of the king.
- 13\_1CH\_26\_31 Among the Hebronites [was] Jerijah the chief, [even] among the Hebronites, according to the generations of his fathers. In the fortieth year of the reign of David they were sought for, and there were found among them mighty men of valour at Jazer of Gilead.
- 13\_1CH\_26\_32 And his brethren, men of valour, [were] two thousand and seven hundred chief fathers, whom king David made rulers over the Reubenites, the Gadites, and the half tribe of Manasseh, for every matter pertaining to God, and affairs of the king.
