- 18\_JOB\_22\_01 Then Eliphaz the Temanite answered and said,
- 18\_JOB\_22\_02 Can a man be profitable unto God, as he that is wise may be profitable unto himself?
- $18\_JOB\_22\_03 \ [Is\ it]\ any\ pleasure\ to\ the\ Almighty,\ that\ thou\ art\ righteous?\ or\ [is\ it]\ gain\ [to\ him],\ that\ thou\ makest\ thy\ ways\ perfect?$
- 18\_JOB\_22\_04 Will he reprove thee for fear of thee? will he enter with thee into judgment?
- 18\_JOB\_22\_05 [Is] not thy wickedness great? and thine iniquities infinite?
- 18\_JOB\_22\_06 For thou hast taken a pledge from thy brother for nought, and stripped the naked of their clothing.
- 18\_JOB\_22\_07 Thou hast not given water to the weary to drink, and thou hast withholden bread from the hungry.
- $18\_JOB\_22\_08$  But [as for] the mighty man, he had the earth; and the honourable man dwelt in it.
- 18\_JOB\_22\_09 Thou hast sent widows away empty, and the arms of the fatherless have been broken.
- 18\_JOB\_22\_10 Therefore snares [are] round about thee, and sudden fear troubleth thee;
- 18\_JOB\_22\_11 Or darkness, [that] thou canst not see; and abundance of waters cover thee.
- 18\_JOB\_22\_12 [Is] not God in the height of heaven? and behold the height of the stars, how high they are!
- $18\_JOB\_22\_13 \ And \ thou \ sayest, How \ doth \ God \ know? \ can \ he \ judge \ through \ the \ dark \ cloud?$
- 18\_JOB\_22\_14 Thick clouds [are] a covering to him, that he seeth not; and he walketh in the circuit of heaven.
- 18\_JOB\_22\_15 Hast thou marked the old way which wicked men have trodden?
- 18 JOB 22 16 Which were cut down out of time, whose foundation was overflown with a flood:
- 18\_JOB\_22\_17 Which said unto God, Depart from us: and what can the Almighty do for them?
- 18\_JOB\_22\_18 Yet he filled their houses with good [things]: but the counsel of the wicked is far from me.
- 18\_JOB\_22\_19 The righteous see [it], and are glad: and the innocent laugh them to scorn.
- 18\_JOB\_22\_20 Whereas our substance is not cut down, but the remnant of them the fire consumeth.
- 18\_JOB\_22\_21 Acquaint now thyself with him, and be at peace: thereby good shall come unto thee.
- 18\_JOB\_22\_22 Receive, I pray thee, the law from his mouth, and lay up his words in thine heart.
- 18\_JOB\_22\_23 If thou return to the Almighty, thou shalt be built up, thou shalt put away iniquity far from thy tabernacles.
- 18\_JOB\_22\_24 Then shalt thou lay up gold as dust, and the [gold] of Ophir as the stones of the brooks.
- 18\_JOB\_22\_25 Yea, the Almighty shall be thy defence, and thou shalt have plenty of silver.
- 18\_JOB\_22\_26 For then shalt thou have thy delight in the Almighty, and shalt lift up thy face unto God.
- 18\_JOB\_22\_27 Thou shalt make thy prayer unto him, and he shall hear thee, and thou shalt pay thy vows.
- 18\_JOB\_22\_28 Thou shalt also decree a thing, and it shall be established unto thee: and the light shall shine upon thy ways.
- $18\_JOB\_22\_29 \ When \ [men] \ are \ cast \ down, \ then \ thou \ shalt \ say, \ [There \ is] \ lifting \ up; \ and \ he \ shall \ save \ the \ humble \ person.$
- $18\_JOB\_22\_30 \ He \ shall \ deliver \ the \ island \ of \ the \ innocent: \ and \ it \ is \ delivered \ by \ the \ pureness \ of \ thine \ hands.$
