

## Book of Job Chapter 35

18\_JOB\_35\_01 Elihu spake moreover, and said,

18\_JOB\_35\_02 Thinkest thou this to be right, [that] thou saidst, My righteousness [is] more than God's?

18\_JOB\_35\_03 For thou saidst, What advantage will it be unto thee? [and], What profit shall I have, [if I be cleansed] from my sin?

18\_JOB\_35\_04 I will answer thee, and thy companions with thee.

18\_JOB\_35\_05 Look unto the heavens, and see; and behold the clouds [which] are higher than thou.

18\_JOB\_35\_06 If thou sinnest, what doest thou against him? or [if] thy transgressions be multiplied, what doest thou unto him?

18\_JOB\_35\_07 If thou be righteous, what givest thou him? or what receiveth he of thine hand?

18\_JOB\_35\_08 Thy wickedness [may hurt] a man as thou [art]; and thy righteousness [may profit] the son of man.

18\_JOB\_35\_09 By reason of the multitude of oppressions they make [the oppressed] to cry: they cry out by reason of the arm of the mighty.

18\_JOB\_35\_10 But none saith, Where [is] God my maker, who giveth songs in the night;

18\_JOB\_35\_11 Who teacheth us more than the beasts of the earth, and maketh us wiser than the fowls of heaven?

18\_JOB\_35\_12 There they cry, but none giveth answer, because of the pride of evil men.

18\_JOB\_35\_13 Surely God will not hear vanity, neither will the Almighty regard it.

18\_JOB\_35\_14 Although thou sayest thou shalt not see him, [yet] judgment [is] before him; therefore trust thou in him.

18\_JOB\_35\_15 But now, because [it is] not [so], he hath visited in his anger; yet he knoweth [it] not in great extremity:

18\_JOB\_35\_16 Therefore doth Job open his mouth in vain; he multiplieth words without knowledge.
