## **Book of Psalms Chapter 18**

- 19\_PSA\_18\_01 To the chief Musician, [A Psalm] of David, the servant of the LORD, who spake unto the LORD the words of this song in the day [that] the LORD delivered him from the hand of all his enemies, and from the hand of Saul: And he said, I will love thee, O LORD, my strength.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_02 The LORD [is] my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the horn of my salvation, [and] my high tower.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_03 I will call upon the LORD, [who is worthy] to be praised: so shall I be saved from mine enemies.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_04 The sorrows of death compassed me, and the floods of ungodly men made me afraid.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_05 The sorrows of hell compassed me about: the snares of death prevented me.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_06 In my distress I called upon the LORD, and cried unto my God: he heard my voice out of his temple, and my cry came before him, [even] into his ears.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_07 Then the earth shook and trembled; the foundations also of the hills moved and were shaken, because he was wroth.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_08 There went up a smoke out of his nostrils, and fire out of his mouth devoured: coals were kindled by it.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_09 He bowed the heavens also, and came down: and darkness [was] under his feet.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_10 And he rode upon a cherub, and did fly: yea, he did fly upon the wings of the wind.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_11 He made darkness his secret place; his pavilion round about him [were] dark waters [and] thick clouds of the skies.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_12 At the brightness [that was] before him his thick clouds passed, hail [stones] and coals of fire.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_13 The LORD also thundered in the heavens, and the Highest gave his voice; hail [stones] and coals of fire.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_14 Yea, he sent out his arrows, and scattered them; and he shot out lightnings, and discomfited them.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_15 Then the channels of waters were seen, and the foundations of the world were discovered at thy rebuke, O LORD, at the blast of the breath of thy nostrils.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_16 He sent from above, he took me, he drew me out of many waters.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_17 He delivered me from my strong enemy, and from them which hated me: for they were too strong for me.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_18 They prevented me in the day of my calamity: but the LORD was my stay.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_19 He brought me forth also into a large place; he delivered me, because he delighted in me.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_20 The LORD rewarded me according to my righteousness; according to the cleanness of my hands hath he recompensed me.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_21 For I have kept the ways of the LORD, and have not wickedly departed from my God.

- 19\_PSA\_18\_22 For all his judgments [were] before me, and I did not put away his statutes from me.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_23 I was also upright before him, and I kept myself from mine iniquity.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_24 Therefore hath the LORD recompensed me according to my righteousness, according to the cleanness of my hands in his eyesight.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_25 With the merciful thou wilt show thyself merciful; with an upright man thou wilt show thyself upright;
- 19\_PSA\_18\_26 With the pure thou wilt show thyself pure; and with the froward thou wilt show thyself froward.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_27 For thou wilt save the afflicted people; but wilt bring down high looks.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_28 For thou wilt light my candle: the LORD my God will enlighten my darkness.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_29 For by thee I have run through a troop; and by my God have I leaped over a wall.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_30 [As for] God, his way [is] perfect: the word of the LORD is tried: he [is] a buckler to all those that trust in him.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_31 For who [is] God save the LORD? or who [is] a rock save our God?
- 19\_PSA\_18\_32 [It is] God that girdeth me with strength, and maketh my way perfect.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_33 He maketh my feet like hinds' [feet], and setteth me upon my high places.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_34 He teacheth my hands to war, so that a bow of steel is broken by mine arms.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_35 Thou hast also given me the shield of thy salvation: and thy right hand hath holden me up, and thy gentleness hath made me great.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_36 Thou hast enlarged my steps under me, that my feet did not slip.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_37 I have pursued mine enemies, and overtaken them: neither did I turn again till they were consumed.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_38 I have wounded them that they were not able to rise: they are fallen under my feet.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_39 For thou hast girded me with strength unto the battle: thou hast subdued under me those that rose up against me.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_40 Thou hast also given me the necks of mine enemies; that I might destroy them that hate me.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_41 They cried, but [there was] none to save [them: even] unto the LORD, but he answered them not.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_42 Then did I beat them small as the dust before the wind: I did cast them out as the dirt in the streets.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_43 Thou hast delivered me from the strivings of the people; [and] thou hast made me the head of the heathen: a people [whom] I have not known shall serve me.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_44 As soon as they hear of me, they shall obey me: the strangers shall submit themselves unto me.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_45 The strangers shall fade away, and be afraid out of their close places.

- 19\_PSA\_18\_46 The LORD liveth; and blessed [be] my rock; and let the God of my salvation be exalted.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_47 [It is] God that avengeth me, and subdueth the people under me.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_48 He delivereth me from mine enemies: yea, thou liftest me up above those that rise up against me: thou hast delivered me from the violent man.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_49 Therefore will I give thanks unto thee, O LORD, among the heathen, and sing praises unto thy name.
- 19\_PSA\_18\_50 Great deliverance giveth he to his king; and showeth mercy to his anointed, to David, and to his seed for evermore.
