Book of Psalms Chapter 63

- 19_PSA_63_01 A Psalm of David, when he was in the wilderness of Judah. O God, thou [art] my God; early will I seek thee: my soul thirsteth for thee, my flesh longeth for thee in a dry and thirsty land, where no water is;
- 19_PSA_63_02 To see thy power and thy glory, so [as] I have seen thee in the sanctuary.
- 19_PSA_63_03 Because thy lovingkindness [is] better than life, my lips shall praise thee.
- 19_PSA_63_04 Thus will I bless thee while I live: I will lift up my hands in thy name.
- 19_PSA_63_05 My soul shall be satisfied as [with] marrow and fatness; and my mouth shall praise [thee] with joyful lips:
- 19_PSA_63_06 When I remember thee upon my bed, [and] meditate on thee in the [night] watches.
- 19_PSA_63_07 Because thou hast been my help, therefore in the shadow of thy wings will I rejoice.
- 19_PSA_63_08 My soul followeth hard after thee: thy right hand upholdeth me.
- 19_PSA_63_09 But those [that] seek my soul, to destroy [it], shall go into the lower parts of the earth.
- 19_PSA_63_10 They shall fall by the sword: they shall be a portion for foxes.
- 19_PSA_63_11 But the king shall rejoice in God; every one that sweareth by him shall glory: but the mouth of them that speak lies shall be stopped.
