- 19\_PSA\_76\_01 To the chief Musician on Neginoth, A Psalm [or] Song of Asaph. In Judah [is] God known: his name [is] great in Israel.
- 19\_PSA\_76\_02 In Salem also is his tabernacle, and his dwelling place in Zion.
- 19\_PSA\_76\_03 There brake he the arrows of the bow, the shield, and the sword, and the battle. Selah.
- 19\_PSA\_76\_04 Thou [art] more glorious [and] excellent than the mountains of prey.
- 19\_PSA\_76\_05 The stouthearted are spoiled, they have slept their sleep: and none of the men of might have found their hands.
- 19\_PSA\_76\_06 At thy rebuke, O God of Jacob, both the chariot and horse are cast into a dead sleep.
- 19\_PSA\_76\_07 Thou, [even] thou, [art] to be feared: and who may stand in thy sight when once thou art angry?
- 19\_PSA\_76\_08 Thou didst cause judgment to be heard from heaven; the earth feared, and was still,
- 19\_PSA\_76\_09 When God arose to judgment, to save all the meek of the earth. Selah.
- 19\_PSA\_76\_10 Surely the wrath of man shall praise thee: the remainder of wrath shalt thou restrain.
- 19\_PSA\_76\_11 Vow, and pay unto the LORD your God: let all that be round about him bring presents unto him that ought to be feared.
- 19\_PSA\_76\_12 He shall cut off the spirit of princes: [he is] terrible to the kings of the earth.
