Book of Psalms Chapter 83

- 19_PSA_83_01 A Song [or] Psalm of Asaph. Keep not thou silence, O God: hold not thy peace, and be not still, O God.
- 19_PSA_83_02 For, lo, thine enemies make a tumult: and they that hate thee have lifted up the head.
- 19_PSA_83_03 They have taken crafty counsel against thy people, and consulted against thy hidden ones.
- 19_PSA_83_04 They have said, Come, and let us cut them off from [being] a nation; that the name of Israel may be no more in remembrance.
- 19_PSA_83_05 For they have consulted together with one consent: they are confederate against thee:
- 19_PSA_83_06 The tabernacles of Edom, and the Ishmaelites; of Moab, and the Hagarenes;
- 19_PSA_83_07 Gebal, and Ammon, and Amalek; the Philistines with the inhabitants of Tyre;
- 19_PSA_83_08 Assur also is joined with them: they have holpen the children of Lot. Selah.
- 19_PSA_83_09 Do unto them as [unto] the Midianites; as [to] Sisera, as [to] Jabin, at the brook of Kison:
- 19_PSA_83_10 [Which] perished at Endor: they became [as] dung for the earth.
- 19_PSA_83_11 Make their nobles like Oreb, and like Zeeb: yea, all their princes as Zebah, and as Zalmunna:
- 19_PSA_83_12 Who said, Let us take to ourselves the houses of God in possession.
- 19_PSA_83_13 O my God, make them like a wheel; as the stubble before the wind.
- 19_PSA_83_14 As the fire burneth a wood, and as the flame setteth the mountains on fire;
- 19_PSA_83_15 So persecute them with thy tempest, and make them afraid with thy storm.
- 19_PSA_83_16 Fill their faces with shame; that they may seek thy name, O LORD.
- 19_PSA_83_17 Let them be confounded and troubled for ever; yea, let them be put to shame, and perish:
- 19_PSA_83_18 That [men] may know that thou, whose name alone [is] JEHOVAH, [art] the most high over all the earth.
