## **Book of Proverbs Chapter 06**

- 20\_PRO\_06\_01 My son, if thou be surety for thy friend, [if] thou hast stricken thy hand with a stranger,
- 20\_PRO\_06\_02 Thou art snared with the words of thy mouth, thou art taken with the words of thy mouth.
- 20\_PRO\_06\_03 Do this now, my son, and deliver thyself, when thou art come into the hand of thy friend; go, humble thyself, and make sure thy friend.
- $20\_PRO\_06\_04$  Give not sleep to thine eyes, nor slumber to thine eyelids.
- 20\_PRO\_06\_05 Deliver thyself as a roe from the hand [of the hunter], and as a bird from the hand of the fowler.
- 20\_PRO\_06\_06 Go to the ant, thou sluggard; consider her ways, and be wise:
- 20\_PRO\_06\_07 Which having no guide, overseer, or ruler,
- 20\_PRO\_06\_08 Provideth her meat in the summer, [and] gathereth her food in the harvest.
- $20\_PRO\_06\_09 \ How \ long \ wilt \ thou \ sleep, O \ sluggard? \ when \ wilt \ thou \ arise \ out \ of \ thy \ sleep?$
- 20\_PRO\_06\_10 [Yet] a little sleep, a little slumber, a little folding of the hands to sleep:
- 20\_PRO\_06\_11 So shall thy poverty come as one that travelleth, and thy want as an armed man-
- 20\_PRO\_06\_12 A naughty person, a wicked man, walketh with a froward mouth.
- $20\_PRO\_06\_13$  He winketh with his eyes, he speaketh with his feet, he teacheth with his fingers;
- 20\_PRO\_06\_14 Frowardness [is] in his heart, he deviseth mischief continually; he soweth discord.
- 20\_PRO\_06\_15 Therefore shall his calamity come suddenly; suddenly shall he be broken without remedy.
- 20 PRO 06 16 These six [things] doth the LORD hate; yea, seven [are] an abomination unto him:
- 20\_PRO\_06\_17 A proud look, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent blood,
- 20\_PRO\_06\_18 An heart that deviseth wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief,
- 20\_PRO\_06\_19 A false witness [that] speaketh lies, and he that soweth discord among brethren.
- $20\_PRO\_06\_20~My~son,$  keep thy father's commandment, and forsake not the law of thy mother:
- 20 PRO 06 21 Bind them continually upon thine heart, [and] tie them about thy neck.
- 20\_PRO\_06\_22 When thou goest, it shall lead thee; when thou sleepest, it shall keep thee; and [when] thou awakest, it shall talk with thee.
- $20\_PRO\_06\_23 \ For \ the \ commandment \ [is] \ a \ lamp; \ and \ the \ law \ [is] \ light; \ and \ reproofs \ of \ instruction \ [are] \ the \ way \ of \ life:$
- 20\_PRO\_06\_24 To keep thee from the evil woman, from the flattery of the tongue of a strange woman.
- 20\_PRO\_06\_25 Lust not after her beauty in thine heart; neither let her take thee with her eyelids.
- 20\_PRO\_06\_26 For by means of a whorish woman [a man is brought] to a piece of bread: and the adulteress will hunt for the precious life.
- 20\_PRO\_06\_27 Can a man take fire in his bosom, and his clothes not be burned?
- 20\_PRO\_06\_28 Can one go upon hot coals, and his feet not be burned?
- 20\_PRO\_06\_29 So he that goeth in to his neighbour's wife; whosoever toucheth her shall not be innocent.
- 20\_PRO\_06\_30 [Men] do not despise a thief, if he steal to satisfy his soul when he is hungry;
- 20\_PRO\_06\_31 But [if] he be found, he shall restore sevenfold; he shall give all the substance of his house.
- 20\_PRO\_06\_32 [But] whoso committeth adultery with a woman lacketh understanding: he [that] doeth it destroyeth his own soul.
- 20\_PRO\_06\_33 A wound and dishonour shall he get; and his reproach shall not be wiped away.
- 20\_PRO\_06\_34 For jealousy [is] the rage of a man: therefore he will not spare in the day of vengeance.
- $20\_PRO\_06\_35 \ He \ will \ not \ regard \ any \ ransom; \ neither \ will \ he \ rest \ content, \ though \ thou \ givest \ many \ gifts.$
