- 20\_PRO\_08\_01 Doth not wisdom cry? and understanding put forth her voice?
- 20\_PRO\_08\_02 She standeth in the top of high places, by the way in the places of the paths.
- 20\_PRO\_08\_03 She crieth at the gates, at the entry of the city, at the coming in at the doors.
- 20\_PRO\_08\_04 Unto you, O men, I call; and my voice [is] to the sons of man.
- 20\_PRO\_08\_05 O ye simple, understand wisdom: and, ye fools, be ye of an understanding heart.
- 20\_PRO\_08\_06 Hear; for I will speak of excellent things; and the opening of my lips [shall be] right things.
- 20\_PRO\_08\_07 For my mouth shall speak truth; and wickedness [is] an abomination to my lips.
- 20\_PRO\_08\_08 All the words of my mouth [are] in righteousness; [there is] nothing froward or perverse in them.
- $20\_PRO\_08\_09 \ They \ [are] \ all \ plain \ to \ him \ that \ understandeth, \ and \ right \ to \ them \ that \ find \ knowledge.$
- 20\_PRO\_08\_10 Receive my instruction, and not silver; and knowledge rather than choice gold.
- 20\_PRO\_08\_11 For wisdom [is] better than rubies; and all the things that may be desired are not to be compared to it.
- 20\_PRO\_08\_12 I wisdom dwell with prudence, and find out knowledge of witty inventions.
- 20\_PRO\_08\_13 The fear of the LORD [is] to hate evil: pride, and arrogancy, and the evil way, and the froward mouth, do I hate.
- $20\_PRO\_08\_14\ Counsel\ [is]\ mine,\ and\ sound\ wisdom:\ I\ [am]\ understanding;\ I\ have\ strength.$
- 20\_PRO\_08\_15 By me kings reign, and princes decree justice.
- 20 PRO 08 16 By me princes rule, and nobles, [even] all the judges of the earth.
- $20\_PRO\_08\_17$  I love them that love me; and those that seek me early shall find me.
- 20\_PRO\_08\_18 Riches and honour [are] with me; [yea], durable riches and righteousness.
- 20\_PRO\_08\_19 My fruit [is] better than gold, yea, than fine gold; and my revenue than choice silver.
- 20 PRO 08 20 I lead in the way of righteousness, in the midst of the paths of judgment:
- 20 PRO 08 21 That I may cause those that love me to inherit substance; and I will fill their treasures.
- 20\_PRO\_08\_22 The LORD possessed me in the beginning of his way, before his works of old.
- $20\_PRO\_08\_23~I$  was set up from everlasting, from the beginning, or ever the earth was.
- 20\_PRO\_08\_24 When [there were] no depths, I was brought forth; when [there were] no fountains abounding with water.
- 20\_PRO\_08\_25 Before the mountains were settled, before the hills was I brought forth:
- 20\_PRO\_08\_26 While as yet he had not made the earth, nor the fields, nor the highest part of the dust of the world.
- 20\_PRO\_08\_27 When he prepared the heavens, I [was] there: when he set a compass upon the face of the depth:
- $20\_PRO\_08\_28$  When he established the clouds above: when he strengthened the fountains of the deep:
- 20\_PRO\_08\_29 When he gave to the sea his decree, that the waters should not pass his commandment: when he appointed the foundations of the earth:
- $20\_PRO\_08\_30 \ Then \ I \ was \ by \ him, [as] \ one \ brought \ up \ [with \ him]: and \ I \ was \ daily \ [his] \ delight, \ rejoicing \ always \ before \ him;$
- 20\_PRO\_08\_31 Rejoicing in the habitable part of his earth; and my delights [were] with the sons of men.
- $20\_PRO\_08\_32 \ Now \ therefore \ hearken \ unto \ me, O \ ye \ children: for \ blessed \ [are \ they \ that] \ keep \ my \ ways.$
- 20\_PRO\_08\_33 Hear instruction, and be wise, and refuse it not.
- $20\_PRO\_08\_34$  Blessed [is] the man that heareth me, watching daily at my gates, waiting at the posts of my doors.
- 20\_PRO\_08\_35 For whoso findeth me findeth life, and shall obtain favour of the LORD.
- 20\_PRO\_08\_36 But he that sinneth against me wrongeth his own soul: all they that hate me love death.
