- 20\_PRO\_21\_01 The king's heart [is] in the hand of the LORD, [as] the rivers of water: he turneth it whithersoever he will.
- 20\_PRO\_21\_02 Every way of a man [is] right in his own eyes: but the LORD pondereth the hearts
- 20\_PRO\_21\_03 To do justice and judgment [is] more acceptable to the LORD than sacrifice.
- 20\_PRO\_21\_04 An high look, and a proud heart, [and] the plowing of the wicked, [is] sin.
- 20\_PRO\_21\_05 The thoughts of the diligent [tend] only to plenteousness; but of every one [that is] hasty only to want.
- 20\_PRO\_21\_06 The getting of treasures by a lying tongue [is] a vanity tossed to and fro of them that seek death.
- 20\_PRO\_21\_07 The robbery of the wicked shall destroy them; because they refuse to do judgment.
- $20\_PRO\_21\_08 \ The \ way \ of \ man \ [is] \ froward \ and \ strange: \ but \ [as \ for] \ the \ pure, \ his \ work \ [is] \ right.$
- 20\_PRO\_21\_09 [It is] better to dwell in a corner of the housetop, than with a brawling woman in a wide house.
- 20\_PRO\_21\_10 The soul of the wicked desireth evil: his neighbour findeth no favour in his eyes.
- 20 PRO 21 11 When the scorner is punished, the simple is made wise; and when the wise is instructed, he receiveth knowledge.
- 20\_PRO\_21\_12 The righteous [man] wisely considereth the house of the wicked: [but God] overthroweth the wicked for [their] wickedness.
- 20\_PRO\_21\_13 Whoso stoppeth his ears at the cry of the poor, he also shall cry himself, but shall not be heard.
- 20\_PRO\_21\_14 A gift in secret pacifieth anger: and a reward in the bosom strong wrath.
- 20\_PRO\_21\_15 [It is] joy to the just to do judgment: but destruction [shall be] to the workers of iniquity.
- 20 PRO 21 16 The man that wandereth out of the way of understanding shall remain in the congregation of the dead.
- 20\_PRO\_21\_17 He that loveth pleasure [shall be] a poor man: he that loveth wine and oil shall not be rich.
- 20\_PRO\_21\_18 The wicked [shall be] a ransom for the righteous, and the transgressor for the upright.
- 20\_PRO\_21\_19 [It is] better to dwell in the wilderness, than with a contentious and an angry woman.
- 20\_PRO\_21\_20 [There is] treasure to be desired and oil in the dwelling of the wise; but a foolish man spendeth it up.
- 20 PRO 21 21 He that followeth after righteousness and mercy findeth life, righteousness, and honour
- 20\_PRO\_21\_22 A wise [man] scaleth the city of the mighty, and casteth down the strength of the confidence thereof.
- $20\_PRO\_21\_23$  Whoso keepeth his mouth and his tongue keepeth his soul from troubles.
- 20\_PRO\_21\_24 Proud [and] haughty scorner [is] his name, who dealeth in proud wrath.
- 20\_PRO\_21\_25 The desire of the slothful killeth him; for his hands refuse to labour.
- 20\_PRO\_21\_26 He coveteth greedily all the day long: but the righteous giveth and spareth not.
- 20\_PRO\_21\_27 The sacrifice of the wicked [is] abomination: how much more, [when] he bringeth it with a wicked mind?
- 20\_PRO\_21\_28 A false witness shall perish: but the man that heareth speaketh constantly.
- 20\_PRO\_21\_29 A wicked man hardeneth his face: but [as for] the upright, he directeth his way.
- $20\_PRO\_21\_30 \ [There is] \ no \ wisdom \ nor \ understanding \ nor \ counsel \ against \ the \ LORD.$
- $20\_PRO\_21\_31$  The horse [is] prepared against the day of battle: but safety [is] of the LORD.
