**Book of Ezekiel Chapter 07**

26\_EZE\_07\_01 Moreover the word of the LORD came unto me, saying,

26\_EZE\_07\_02 Also, thou son of man, thus saith the Lord GOD unto the land of Israel; An end, the end is come upon the four corners of the land.

26\_EZE\_07\_03 Now [is] the end [come] upon thee, and I will send mine anger upon thee, and will judge thee according to thy ways, and will recompense upon thee all thine abominations.

26\_EZE\_07\_04 And mine eye shall not spare thee, neither will I have pity: but I will recompense thy ways upon thee, and thine abominations shall be in the midst of thee: and ye shall know that I [am] the LORD.

26\_EZE\_07\_05 Thus saith the Lord GOD; An evil, an only evil, behold, is come.

26\_EZE\_07\_06 An end is come, the end is come: it watcheth for thee; behold, it is come.

26\_EZE\_07\_07 The morning is come unto thee, O thou that dwellest in the land: the time is come, the day of trouble [is] near, and not the sounding again of the mountains.

26\_EZE\_07\_08 Now will I shortly pour out my fury upon thee, and accomplish mine anger upon thee: and I will judge thee according to thy ways, and will recompense thee for all thine abominations.

26\_EZE\_07\_09 And mine eye shall not spare, neither will I have pity: I will recompense thee according to thy ways and thine abominations [that] are in the midst of thee; and ye shall know that I [am] the LORD that smiteth.

26\_EZE\_07\_10 Behold the day, behold, it is come: the morning is gone forth; the rod hath blossomed, pride hath budded.

26\_EZE\_07\_11 Violence is risen up into a rod of wickedness: none of them [shall remain], nor of their multitude, nor of any of theirs: neither [shall there be] wailing for them.

26\_EZE\_07\_12 The time is come, the day draweth near: let not the buyer rejoice, nor the seller mourn: for wrath [is] upon all the multitude thereof.

26\_EZE\_07\_13 For the seller shall not return to that which is sold, although they were yet alive: for the vision [is] touching the whole multitude thereof, [which] shall not return; neither shall any strengthen himself in the iniquity of his life.

26\_EZE\_07\_14 They have blown the trumpet, even to make all ready; but none goeth to the battle: for my wrath [is] upon all the multitude thereof.

26\_EZE\_07\_15 The sword [is] without, and the pestilence and the famine within: he that [is] in the field shall die with the sword; and he that [is] in the city, famine and pestilence shall devour him.

26\_EZE\_07\_16 But they that escape of them shall escape, and shall be on the mountains like doves of the valleys, all of them mourning, every one for his iniquity.

26\_EZE\_07\_17 All hands shall be feeble, and all knees shall be weak [as] water.

26\_EZE\_07\_18 They shall also gird [themselves] with sackcloth, and horror shall cover them; and shame [shall be] upon all faces, and baldness upon all their heads.

26\_EZE\_07\_19 They shall cast their silver in the streets, and their gold shall be removed: their silver and their gold shall not be able to deliver them in the day of the wrath of the LORD: they shall not satisfy their souls, neither fill their bowels: because it is the stumblingblock of their iniquity.

26\_EZE\_07\_20 As for the beauty of his ornament, he set it in majesty: but they made the images of their abominations [and] of their detestable things therein: therefore have I set it far from them.

26\_EZE\_07\_21 And I will give it into the hands of the strangers for a prey, and to the wicked of the earth for a spoil; and they shall pollute it.

26\_EZE\_07\_22 My face will I turn also from them, and they shall pollute my secret [place]: for the robbers shall enter into it, and defile it.

26\_EZE\_07\_23 Make a chain: for the land is full of bloody crimes, and the city is full of violence.

26\_EZE\_07\_24 Wherefore I will bring the worst of the heathen, and they shall possess their houses: I will also make the pomp of the strong to cease; and their holy places shall be defiled.

26\_EZE\_07\_25 Destruction cometh; and they shall seek peace, and [there shall be] none.

26\_EZE\_07\_26 Mischief shall come upon mischief, and rumour shall be upon rumour; then shall they seek a vision of the prophet; but the law shall perish from the priest, and counsel from the ancients.

26\_EZE\_07\_27 The king shall mourn, and the prince shall be clothed with desolation, and the hands of the people of the land shall be troubled: I will do unto them after their way, and according to their deserts will I judge them; and they shall know that I [am] the LORD.
