## Page 1 Book of Ezekiel Chapter 14

- 26\_EZE\_14\_01 Then came certain of the elders of Israel unto me, and sat before me.
- 26\_EZE\_14\_02 And the word of the LORD came unto me, saying.
- 26\_EZE\_14\_03 Son of man, these men have set up their idols in their heart, and put the stumblingblock of their iniquity before their face: should I be inquired of at all by them?
- 26\_EZE\_14\_04 Therefore speak unto them, and say unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Every man of the house of Israel that setteth up his idols in his heart, and putteth the stumblingblock of his iniquity before his face, and cometh to the prophet; I the LORD will answer him that cometh according to the multitude of his idols;
- 26\_EZE\_14\_05 That I may take the house of Israel in their own heart, because they are all estranged from me through their idols.
- 26\_EZE\_14\_06 Therefore say unto the house of Israel, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Repent, and turn [yourselves] from your idols; and turn away your faces from all your abominations
- 26\_EZE\_14\_07 For every one of the house of Israel, or of the stranger that sojourneth in Israel, which separateth himself from me, and setteth up his idols in his heart, and putteth the stumblingblock of his iniquity before his face, and cometh to a prophet to inquire of him concerning me; I the LORD will answer him by myself:
- 26\_EZE\_14\_08 And I will set my face against that man, and will make him a sign and a proverb, and I will cut him off from the midst of my people; and ye shall know that I [am] the LORD.
- 26\_EZE\_14\_09 And if the prophet be deceived when he hath spoken a thing, I the LORD have deceived that prophet, and I will stretch out my hand upon him, and will destroy him from the midst of my people Israel.
- 26 EZE 14 10 And they shall bear the punishment of their iniquity: the punishment of the prophet shall be even as the punishment of him that seeketh [unto him]:
- 26\_EZE\_14\_11 That the house of Israel may go no more astray from me, neither be polluted any more with all their transgressions; but that they may be my people, and I may be their God, saith the Lord GOD.
- 26\_EZE\_14\_12 The word of the LORD came again to me, saying,
- 26\_EZE\_14\_13 Son of man, when the land sinneth against me by trespassing grievously, then will I stretch out mine hand upon it, and will break the staff of the bread thereof, and will send famine upon it, and will cut off man and beast from it:
- 26\_EZE\_14\_14 Though these three men, Noah, Daniel, and Job, were in it, they should deliver [but] their own souls by their righteousness, saith the Lord GOD.
- 26\_EZE\_14\_15 If I cause noisome beasts to pass through the land, and they spoil it, so that it be desolate, that no man may pass through because of the beasts:
- 26\_EZE\_14\_16 [Though] these three men [were] in it, [as] I live, saith the Lord GOD, they shall deliver neither sons nor daughters; they only shall be delivered, but the land shall be desolate.
- 26\_EZE\_14\_17 Or [if] I bring a sword upon that land, and say, Sword, go through the land; so that I cut off man and beast from it:
- 26\_EZE\_14\_18 Though these three men [were] in it, [as] I live, saith the Lord GOD, they shall deliver neither sons nor daughters, but they only shall be delivered themselves.
- $26\_EZE\_14\_19 \ Or \ [if] \ I \ send \ a \ pestilence \ into \ that \ land, \ and \ pour \ out \ my \ fury \ upon \ it \ in \ blood, \ to \ cut \ off \ from \ it \ man \ and \ beast:$
- 26\_EZE\_14\_20 Though Noah, Daniel, and Job, [were] in it, [as] I live, saith the Lord GOD, they shall deliver neither son nor daughter; they shall [but] deliver their own souls by their righteousness
- 26\_EZE\_14\_21 For thus saith the Lord GOD; How much more when I send my four sore judgments upon Jerusalem, the sword, and the famine, and the noisome beast, and the pestilence, to cut off from it man and beast?
- 26\_EZE\_14\_22 Yet, behold, therein shall be left a remnant that shall be brought forth, [both] sons and daughters: behold, they shall come forth unto you, and ye shall see their way and their doings: and ye shall be comforted concerning the evil that I have brought upon Jerusalem, [even] concerning all that I have brought upon it.
- 26\_EZE\_14\_23 And they shall comfort you, when ye see their ways and their doings: and ye shall know that I have not done without cause all that I have done in it, saith the Lord GOD.
