## **Book of Matthew Chapter 10**

- 40\_MAT\_10\_01 And when he had called unto [him] his twelve disciples, he gave them power [against] unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all manner of sickness and all manner of disease.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_02 Now the names of the twelve apostles are these; The first, Simon, who is called Peter, and Andrew his brother; James [the son] of Zebedee, and John his brother;
- 40\_MAT\_10\_03 Philip, and Bartholomew; Thomas, and Matthew the publican; James [the son] of Alphaeus, and Lebbaeus, whose surname was Thaddaeus;
- 40\_MAT\_10\_04 Simon the Canaanite, and Judas Iscariot, who also betrayed him.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_05 These twelve Jesus sent forth, and commanded them, saying, Go not into the way of the Gentiles, and into [any] city of the Samaritans enter ye not:
- 40\_MAT\_10\_06 But go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_07 And as ye go, preach, saying, The kingdom of heaven is at hand.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_08 Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_09 Provide neither gold, nor silver, nor brass in your purses,
- 40\_MAT\_10\_10 Nor scrip for [your] journey, neither two coats, neither shoes, nor yet staves: for the workman is worthy of his meat.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_11 And into whatsoever city or town ye shall enter, inquire who in it is worthy; and there abide till ye go thence.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_12 And when ye come into an house, salute it.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_13 And if the house be worthy, let your peace come upon it: but if it be not worthy, let your peace return to you.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_14 And whosoever shall not receive you, nor hear your words, when ye depart out of that house or city, shake off the dust of your feet.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_15 Verily I say unto you, It shall be more tolerable for the land of Sodom and Gomorrha in the day of judgment, than for that city.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_16 Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents, and harmless as doves.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_17 But beware of men: for they will deliver you up to the councils, and they will scourge you in their synagogues;
- 40\_MAT\_10\_18 And ye shall be brought before governors and kings for my sake, for a testimony against them and the Gentiles.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_19 But when they deliver you up, take no thought how or what ye shall speak: for it shall be given you in that same hour what ye shall speak.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_20 For it is not ye that speak, but the Spirit of your Father which speaketh in you.

- 40\_MAT\_10\_21 And the brother shall deliver up the brother to death, and the father the child: and the children shall rise up against [their] parents, and cause them to be put to death.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_22 And ye shall be hated of all [men] for my name's sake: but he that endureth to the end shall be saved.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_23 But when they persecute you in this city, flee ye into another: for verily I say unto you, Ye shall not have gone over the cities of Israel, till the Son of man be come.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_24 The disciple is not above [his] master, nor the servant above his lord.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_25 It is enough for the disciple that he be as his master, and the servant as his lord. If they have called the master of the house Beelzebub, how much more [shall they call] them of his household?
- 40\_MAT\_10\_26 Fear them not therefore: for there is nothing covered, that shall not be revealed; and hid, that shall not be known.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_27 What I tell you in darkness, [that] speak ye in light: and what ye hear in the ear, [that] preach ye upon the housetops.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_28 And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_29 Are not two sparrows sold for a farthing? and one of them shall not fall on the ground without your Father.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_30 But the very hairs of your head are all numbered.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_31 Fear ye not therefore, ye are of more value than many sparrows.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_32 Whosoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before my Father which is in heaven.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_33 But whosoever shall deny me before men, him will I also deny before my Father which is in heaven.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_34 Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I came not to send peace, but a sword.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_35 For I am come to set a man at variance against his father, and the daughter against her mother, and the daughter in law against her mother in law.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_36 And a man's foes [shall be] they of his own household.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_37 He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_38 And he that taketh not his cross, and followeth after me, is not worthy of me.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_39 He that findeth his life shall lose it: and he that loseth his life for my sake shall find it.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_40 He that receiveth you receiveth me, and he that receiveth me receiveth him that sent me.
- 40\_MAT\_10\_41 He that receiveth a prophet in the name of a prophet shall receive a prophet's reward; and he that receiveth a righteous man in the name of a righteous man shall receive a righteous man's reward.

40\_MAT\_10\_42 And whosoever shall give to drink unto one of these little ones a cup of cold [water] only in the name of a disciple, verily I say unto you, he shall in no wise lose his reward.
