## Page 1 **Book of Mark Chapter 03**

- 41\_MAR\_03\_01 And he entered again into the synagogue; and there was a man there which had a withered hand.
- 41\_MAR\_03\_02 And they watched him, whether he would heal him on the sabbath day; that they might accuse him.
- 41\_MAR\_03\_03 And he saith unto the man which had the withered hand, Stand forth.
- 41\_MAR\_03\_04 And he saith unto them, Is it lawful to do good on the sabbath days, or to do evil? to save life, or to kill? But they held their peace.
- 41\_MAR\_03\_05 And when he had looked round about on them with anger, being grieved for the hardness of their hearts, he saith unto the man, Stretch forth thine hand. And he stretched [it] out: and his hand was restored whole as the other.
- 41\_MAR\_03\_06 And the Pharisees went forth, and straightway took counsel with the Herodians against him, how they might destroy him.
- 41\_MAR\_03\_07 But Jesus withdrew himself with his disciples to the sea: and a great multitude from Galilee followed him, and from Judaea,
- 41\_MAR\_03\_08 And from Jerusalem, and from Idumaea, and [from] beyond Jordan; and they about Tyre and Sidon, a great multitude, when they had heard what great things he did, came unto him.
- 41\_MAR\_03\_09 And he spake to his disciples, that a small ship should wait on him because of the multitude, lest they should throng him.
- 41\_MAR\_03\_10 For he had healed many; insomuch that they pressed upon him for to touch him, as many as had plagues.
- 41\_MAR\_03\_11 And unclean spirits, when they saw him, fell down before him, and cried, saying, Thou art the Son of God.
- 41\_MAR\_03\_12 And he straitly charged them that they should not make him known.
- 41 MAR 03 13 And he goeth up into a mountain, and calleth [unto him] whom he would; and they came unto him.
- 41\_MAR\_03\_14 And he ordained twelve, that they should be with him, and that he might send them forth to preach,
- $41\_MAR\_03\_15$  And to have power to heal sicknesses, and to cast out devils:
- 41\_MAR\_03\_16 And Simon he surnamed Peter;
- 41\_MAR\_03\_17 And James the [son] of Zebedee, and John the brother of James; and he surnamed them Boanerges, which is, The sons of thunder:
- 41\_MAR\_03\_18 And Andrew, and Philip, and Bartholomew, and Matthew, and Thomas, and James the [son] of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus, and Simon the Canaanite,
- 41\_MAR\_03\_19 And Judas Iscariot, which also betrayed him: and they went into an house.
- 41\_MAR\_03\_20 And the multitude cometh together again, so that they could not so much as eat bread.
- 41\_MAR\_03\_21 And when his friends heard [of it], they went out to lay hold on him: for they said, He is beside himself.
- 41\_MAR\_03\_22 And the scribes which came down from Jerusalem said, He hath Beelzebub, and by the prince of the devils casteth he out devils.
- 41\_MAR\_03\_23 And he called them [unto him], and said unto them in parables, How can Satan cast out Satan?
- 41\_MAR\_03\_24 And if a kingdom be divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand.
- 41\_MAR\_03\_25 And if a house be divided against itself, that house cannot stand.
- 41\_MAR\_03\_26 And if Satan rise up against himself, and be divided, he cannot stand, but hath an end.
- 41\_MAR\_03\_27 No man can enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he will first bind the strong man; and then he will spoil his house.
- 41\_MAR\_03\_28 Verily I say unto you, All sins shall be forgiven unto the sons of men, and blasphemies wherewith soever they shall blasphemes
- 41\_MAR\_03\_29 But he that shall blaspheme against the Holy Ghost hath never forgiveness, but is in danger of eternal damnation
- $41\_MAR\_03\_30$  Because they said, He hath an unclean spirit.
- $41\_MAR\_03\_31$  There came then his brethren and his mother, and, standing without, sent unto him, calling him.
- 41\_MAR\_03\_32 And the multitude sat about him, and they said unto him, Behold, thy mother and thy brethren without seek for thee.
- 41\_MAR\_03\_33 And he answered them, saying, Who is my mother, or my brethren?
- 41\_MAR\_03\_34 And he looked round about on them which sat about him, and said, Behold my mother and my brethren!
- $41\_MAR\_03\_35 \ For \ whosoever \ shall \ do \ the \ will \ of \ God, \ the \ same \ is \ my \ brother, \ and \ my \ sister, \ and \ mother.$
