

## Book of Luke Chapter 02

42\_LUK\_02\_01 And it came to pass in those days, that there went out a decree from Caesar Augustus, that all the world should be taxed.

42\_LUK\_02\_02 [[And] this taxing was first made when Cyrenius was governor of Syria.]

42\_LUK\_02\_03 And all went to be taxed, every one into his own city.

42\_LUK\_02\_04 And Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judaea, unto the city of David, which is called Bethlehem; [because he was of the house and lineage of David:]

42\_LUK\_02\_05 To be taxed with Mary his espoused wife, being great with child.

42\_LUK\_02\_06 And so it was, that, while they were there, the days were accomplished that she should be delivered.

42\_LUK\_02\_07 And she brought forth her firstborn son, and wrapped him in swaddling clothes, and laid him in a manger; because there was no room for them in the inn.

42\_LUK\_02\_08 And there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night.

42\_LUK\_02\_09 And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and the glory of the Lord shone round about them: and they were sore afraid.

42\_LUK\_02\_10 And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people.

42\_LUK\_02\_11 For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord.

42\_LUK\_02\_12 And this [shall be] a sign unto you; Ye shall find the babe wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a manger.

42\_LUK\_02\_13 And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying,

42\_LUK\_02\_14 Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men.

42\_LUK\_02\_15 And it came to pass, as the angels were gone away from them into heaven, the shepherds said one to another, Let us now go even unto Bethlehem, and see this thing which is come to pass, which the Lord hath made known unto us.

42\_LUK\_02\_16 And they came with haste, and found Mary, and Joseph, and the babe lying in a manger.

42\_LUK\_02\_17 And when they had seen [it], they made known abroad the saying which was told them concerning this child.

42\_LUK\_02\_18 And all they that heard [it] wondered at those things which were told them by the shepherds.

42\_LUK\_02\_19 But Mary kept all these things, and pondered [them] in her heart.

42\_LUK\_02\_20 And the shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things that they had heard and seen, as it was told unto them.

42\_LUK\_02\_21 And when eight days were accomplished for the circumcising of the child, his name was called JESUS, which was so named of the angel before he was conceived in the womb.

42\_LUK\_02\_22 And when the days of her purification according to the law of Moses were accomplished, they brought him to Jerusalem, to present [him] to the Lord;

42\_LUK\_02\_23 [As it is written in the law of the Lord, Every male that openeth the womb shall be called holy to the Lord;]

42\_LUK\_02\_24 And to offer a sacrifice according to that which is said in the law of the Lord, A pair of turtledoves, or two young pigeons.

42\_LUK\_02\_25 And, behold, there was a man in Jerusalem, whose name [was] Simeon; and the same man [was] just and devout, waiting for the consolation of Israel: and the Holy Ghost was upon him.

42\_LUK\_02\_26 And it was revealed unto him by the Holy Ghost, that he should not see death, before he had seen the Lord's Christ.

42\_LUK\_02\_27 And he came by the Spirit into the temple: and when the parents brought in the child Jesus, to do for him after the custom of the law,

42\_LUK\_02\_28 Then took he him up in his arms, and blessed God, and said,

42\_LUK\_02\_29 Lord, now lettest thou thy servant depart in peace, according to thy word:

42\_LUK\_02\_30 For mine eyes have seen thy salvation,

42\_LUK\_02\_31 Which thou hast prepared before the face of all people;

42\_LUK\_02\_32 A light to lighten the Gentiles, and the glory of thy people Israel.

42\_LUK\_02\_33 And Joseph and his mother marvelled at those things which were spoken of him.

42\_LUK\_02\_34 And Simeon blessed them, and said unto Mary his mother, Behold, this [child] is set for the fall and rising again of many in Israel; and for a sign which shall be spoken against;

42\_LUK\_02\_35 [Yea, a sword shall pierce through thy own soul also,] that the thoughts of many hearts may be revealed.

42\_LUK\_02\_36 And there was one Anna, a prophetess, the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Aser: she was of a great age, and had lived with an husband seven years from her virginity;

42\_LUK\_02\_37 And she [was] a widow of about fourscore and four years, which departed not from the temple, but served [God] with fastings and prayers night and day.

42\_LUK\_02\_38 And she coming in that instant gave thanks likewise unto the Lord, and spake of him to all them that looked for redemption in Jerusalem.

42\_LUK\_02\_39 And when they had performed all things according to the law of the Lord, they returned into Galilee, to their own city Nazareth.

42\_LUK\_02\_40 And the child grew, and waxed strong in spirit, filled with wisdom: and the grace of God was upon him.

42\_LUK\_02\_41 Now his parents went to Jerusalem every year at the feast of the passover.

42\_LUK\_02\_42 And when he was twelve years old, they went up to Jerusalem after the custom of the feast.

42\_LUK\_02\_43 And when they had fulfilled the days, as they returned, the child Jesus tarried behind in Jerusalem; and Joseph and his mother knew not [of it].

42\_LUK\_02\_44 But they, supposing him to have been in the company, went a day's journey; and they sought him among [their] kinsfolk and acquaintance.

42\_LUK\_02\_45 And when they found him not, they turned back again to Jerusalem, seeking him.

42\_LUK\_02\_46 And it came to pass, that after three days they found him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the doctors, both hearing them, and asking them questions.

42\_LUK\_02\_47 And all that heard him were astonished at his understanding and answers.

42\_LUK\_02\_48 And when they saw him, they were amazed: and his mother said unto him, Son, why hast thou thus dealt with us? behold, thy father and I have sought thee sorrowing.

42\_LUK\_02\_49 And he said unto them, How is it that ye sought me? wist ye not that I must be about my Father's business?

42\_LUK\_02\_50 And they understood not the saying which he spake unto them.

42\_LUK\_02\_51 And he went down with them, and came to Nazareth, and was subject unto them: but his mother kept all these sayings in her heart.

42\_LUK\_02\_52 And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favour with God and man.
