## **Book of Philippians Chapter 02**

- 50\_PHP\_02\_01 If [there be] therefore any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any bowels and mercies,
- 50\_PHP\_02\_02 Fulfil ye my joy, that ye be likeminded, having the same love, [being] of one accord, of one mind.
- 50\_PHP\_02\_03 [Let] nothing [be done] through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind let each esteem other better than themselves.
- 50\_PHP\_02\_04 Look not every man on his own things, but every man also on the things of others.
- 50 PHP 02 05 Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:
- 50\_PHP\_02\_06 Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:
- 50\_PHP\_02\_07 But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men:
- 50\_PHP\_02\_08 And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.
- 50\_PHP\_02\_09 Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name:
- 50\_PHP\_02\_10 That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of [things] in heaven, and [things] in earth, and [things] under the earth;
- 50\_PHP\_02\_11 And [that] every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ [is] Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
- 50\_PHP\_02\_12 Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling.
- $50\_PHP\_02\_13$  For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to do of [his] good pleasure.
- $50\_PHP\_02\_14$  Do all things without murmurings and disputings:
- 50\_PHP\_02\_15 That ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world;
- 50 PHP 02 16 Holding forth the word of life; that I may rejoice in the day of Christ, that I have not run in vain, neither laboured in vain.
- 50\_PHP\_02\_17 Yea, and if I be offered upon the sacrifice and service of your faith, I joy, and rejoice with you all.
- $50\_PHP\_02\_18$  For the same cause also do ye joy, and rejoice with me.
- 50\_PHP\_02\_19 But I trust in the Lord Jesus to send Timotheus shortly unto you, that I also may be of good comfort, when I know your state.
- $50\_PHP\_02\_20$  For I have no man likeminded, who will naturally care for your state.
- 50 PHP 02 21 For all seek their own, not the things which are Jesus Christ's.
- 50\_PHP\_02\_22 But ye know the proof of him, that, as a son with the father, he hath served with me in the gospel.
- $50\_PHP\_02\_23$  Him therefore I hope to send presently, so soon as I shall see how it will go with me.
- 50\_PHP\_02\_24 But I trust in the Lord that I also myself shall come shortly.
- 50\_PHP\_02\_25 Yet I supposed it necessary to send to you Epaphroditus, my brother, and companion in labour, and fellowsoldier, but your messenger, and he that ministered to my wants.
- 50\_PHP\_02\_26 For he longed after you all, and was full of heaviness, because that ye had heard that he had been sick.
- 50\_PHP\_02\_27 For indeed he was sick nigh unto death: but God had mercy on him; and not on him only, but on me also, lest I should have sorrow upon sorrow.
- 50\_PHP\_02\_28 I sent him therefore the more carefully, that, when ye see him again, ye may rejoice, and that I may be the less sorrowful.
- 50\_PHP\_02\_29 Receive him therefore in the Lord with all gladness; and hold such in reputation:
- $50\_PHP\_02\_30\ Because\ for\ the\ work\ of\ Christ\ he\ was\ nigh\ unto\ death,\ not\ regarding\ his\ life,\ to\ supply\ your\ lack\ of\ service\ toward\ me.$
