**Book of 2nd Timothy Chapter 04**

55\_2TI\_04\_01 I charge [thee] therefore before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the quick and the dead at his appearing and his kingdom;

55\_2TI\_04\_02 Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine.

55\_2TI\_04\_03 For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears;

55\_2TI\_04\_04 And they shall turn away [their] ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables.

55\_2TI\_04\_05 But watch thou in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, make full proof of thy ministry.

55\_2TI\_04\_06 For I am now ready to be offered, and the time of my departure is at hand.

55\_2TI\_04\_07 I have fought a good fight, I have finished [my] course, I have kept the faith:

55\_2TI\_04\_08 Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that love his appearing.

55\_2TI\_04\_09 Do thy diligence to come shortly unto me:

55\_2TI\_04\_10 For Demas hath forsaken me, having loved this present world, and is departed unto Thessalonica; Crescens to Galatia, Titus unto Dalmatia.

55\_2TI\_04\_11 Only Luke is with me. Take Mark, and bring him with thee: for he is profitable to me for the ministry.

55\_2TI\_04\_12 And Tychicus have I sent to Ephesus.

55\_2TI\_04\_13 The cloak that I left at Troas with Carpus, when thou comest, bring [with thee], and the books, [but] especially the parchments.

55\_2TI\_04\_14 Alexander the coppersmith did me much evil: the Lord reward him according to his works:

55\_2TI\_04\_15 Of whom be thou ware also; for he hath greatly withstood our words.

55\_2TI\_04\_16 At my first answer no man stood with me, but all [men] forsook me: [I pray God] that it may not be laid to their charge.

55\_2TI\_04\_17 Notwithstanding the Lord stood with me, and strengthened me; that by me the preaching might be fully known, and [that] all the Gentiles might hear: and I was delivered out of the mouth of the lion.

55\_2TI\_04\_18 And the Lord shall deliver me from every evil work, and will preserve [me] unto his heavenly kingdom: to whom [be] glory for ever and ever. Amen.

55\_2TI\_04\_19 Salute Prisca and Aquila, and the household of Onesiphorus.

55\_2TI\_04\_20 Erastus abode at Corinth: but Trophimus have I left at Miletum sick.

55\_2TI\_04\_21 Do thy diligence to come before winter. Eubulus greeteth thee, and Pudens, and Linus, and Claudia, and all the brethren.

55\_2TI\_04\_22 The Lord Jesus Christ [be] with thy spirit. Grace [be] with you. Amen.
