

## Book of Titus Chapter 02

56\_TIT\_02\_01 But speak thou the things which become sound doctrine:

56\_TIT\_02\_02 That the aged men be sober, grave, temperate, sound in faith, in charity, in patience.

56\_TIT\_02\_03 The aged women likewise, that [they be] in behaviour as becometh holiness, not false accusers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things;

56\_TIT\_02\_04 That they may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children,

56\_TIT\_02\_05 [To be] discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God be not blasphemed.

56\_TIT\_02\_06 Young men likewise exhort to be sober minded.

56\_TIT\_02\_07 In all things showing thyself a pattern of good works: in doctrine [showing] uncorruptness, gravity, sincerity,

56\_TIT\_02\_08 Sound speech, that cannot be condemned; that he that is of the contrary part may be ashamed, having no evil thing to say of you.

56\_TIT\_02\_09 [Exhort] servants to be obedient unto their own masters, [and] to please [them] well in all [things]; not answering again;

56\_TIT\_02\_10 Not purloining, but showing all good fidelity; that they may adorn the doctrine of God our Saviour in all things.

56\_TIT\_02\_11 For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men,

56\_TIT\_02\_12 Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world;

56\_TIT\_02\_13 Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ;

56\_TIT\_02\_14 Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.

56\_TIT\_02\_15 These things speak, and exhort, and rebuke with all authority. Let no man despise thee.
