Bartholomeus 0918 # Bartholomaios {bar-thol-om-ah'-yos}: of Aramaic origin [1247 and 8526]: son of Tolmai; Bar-tholomeus, a Christian apostle: -- {Bartholomeus}. [ql

Bartimaeus 0924 # Bartimaios {bar-tim-ah'-yos}: of Aramaic origin [1247 and 2931]: son of Timoeus (or the unclean); Bartimoeus, an Israeli te: -- {Bartimaeus}. [ql
