daily 1967 # epiousios {ep-ee-oo' -see-os}; perhaps from the same as 1966; tomorrow's; but more probably from 1909 and a derivative of the present participle feminine of 1510; for subsistence, i.e. needful: -- {daily}. [q]

following 1966 # epiousa {ep-ee-oo' -sah}; feminine singular participle of a comparative of 1909 and heimi (to go); supervening, i.e. (2250 or 3571 being expressed or implied) the ensuing day or night: -- {following}, next. [q]

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
