and 5346); to speak or say (by word or writing): -- answer, bid, bring word, call, command, {grant}, say (on), speak, tell. Compare 3004. [q]

Hermes 2060 # Hermes {her-mace' }; perhaps from 2046; Hermes, the name of the messenger of the Greek deities; also of a Christian: -- {Hermes}, Mercury. [q]

intreat 2065 # erotao {er-o-tah' -o}; apparently from 2046 [compare 2045]; to interrogate; by implication, to request: -- ask, beseech, desire, {intreat}, pray. Compare 4441. [q]

Mercury 2060 # Hermes {her-mace' }; perhaps from 2046; Hermes, the name of the messenger of the Greek deities; also of a Christian: -- Hermes, {Mercury}. [q]
