join 4801 # suzeugnumi {sood-zyoog' -noo-mee}; from 4862 and the base of 2201; to yoke together, i.e. (figuratively) conjoin (in marriage): -- {join} together. [q]

pair 2201 # zeugos {dzyoo' -gos}; from the same as 2218; a couple, i.e. a team (of oxen yoked together) or brace (of birds tied together): -- yoke, {pair}. [q]
