coast 3864 # parathalassios {par-ath-al-as'-see-os}; from 3844 and 2281; along the sea, i.e. maritime (lacustrine): -- upon the sea {coast}. [q]

meet 1337 # di thalassos {dee-thal'-as-sos}; from 1364 and 2281; having two seas, i.e. a sound with a double outlet: -- where two seas {meet}. [q]

red 2063 # eruthros {er-oo-thros'}; of uncertain affinity; red, i.e. (with 2281) the Red Sea: -- {red}. [q]

sea 2281 # thalassa {thal'-as-sah}; probably prolonged from 251; the sea (genitive case or specially): -- {sea}. [q]
