course 5143 # trecho {trekh'-o}; apparently a primary verb (properly, threcho; compare 2359); which uses dremo {drem'-o} (the base of 1408) as alternate in certain tenses; to run or walk hastily (literally or figuratively): -- have {course}, run. [q]

hair 2359 # thrix {threeks}; genitive case trichos, etc.; of uncertain derivation; hair: -- {hair}. Compare 2864. [q]

hair 2864 # kome {kom'-ay}; apparently from the same as 2865; the hair of the head (locks, as ornamental, and thus differing from 2359; which properly denotes merely the scalp): -- {hair}. [q]

hair 5155 # trichinos {trikh'-ee-nos}; from 2359; hairy, i.e. made of hair (mohair): -- of {hair}. [q]

have 5143 # trecho {trekh'-o}; apparently a primary verb (properly, threcho; compare 2359); which uses dremo {drem'-o} (the base of 1408) as alternate in certain tenses; to run or walk hastily (literally or figuratively): -- {have} course, run. [q]
