filth 4027 # perikatharma {per-ee-kath'-ar-mah}; from a compound of 4012 and 2508; something cleaned off all around, i.e. refuse (figuratively): -- {filth}. [q]

foul 0169 # akathartos {ak-ath'-ar-tos}; from 1 (as a negative particle) and a presumed derivative of 2508 (meaning cleansed); impure (ceremonially, morally [lewd] or specially, [demonic]): -- {foul}, unclean. [q]

out 1571 # ekkathairo {ek-kath-ah'-ee-ro}; from 1537 and 2508; to cleanse thoroughly: -- purge ({out}). [q]

purge 1571 # ekkathairo {ek-kath-ah'-ee-ro}; from 1537 and 2508; to cleanse thoroughly: -- {purge} (out). [q]

purge 2508 # kathairo {kath-ah'-ee-ro}; from 2513; to cleanse, i.e. (specially) to prune; figuratively, to expiate: -- {purge}. [q]

unclean 0169 # akathartos {ak-ath'-ar-tos}; from 1 (as a negative particle) and a presumed derivative of 2508 (meaning cleansed); impure (ceremonially, morally [lewd] or specially, [demonic]): -- foul, {unclean}. [q]

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
