adorn 2885 # kosmeo {kos-meh'-o}; from 2889; to put in proper order, i.e. decorate (literally or figuratively); specially, to snuff (a wick): -- {adorn}, garnish, trim. [q]

adorning 2889 # kosmos {kos'-mos}; probably from the base of 2865; orderly arrangement, i.e. decoration; by implication, the world (in a wide or narrow sense, including its inhabitants, literally or figuratively [morally]): -- {adorning}, world. [q]

bag 1101 # glossokomon {gloce-sok'-om-on}; from 1100 and the base of 2889; properly, a case (to keep mouthpieces of wind-instruments in) i.e. (by extension) a casket or (specially) purse: -- {bag}. [q]
