

impenitent 0279 # Expanded Dictionary Study

impenitent 0279 # ametanoetos {am-et-an-o'-ay-tos}; from 1 (as a negative particle) and a presumed derivative of 3340; unrepentant: -- {impenitent}. [q]

repent 3340 # metanoeo {met-an-o-eh'-o}; from 3326 and 3539; to think differently or afterwards, i.e. reconsider (morally, feel compunction): -- {repent}. [q]

repentance 3341 # metanoia {met-an'-oy-ah}; from 3340; (subjectively) compunction (for guilt, including reformation); by implication reversal (of [another's] decision): -- {repentance}. [q]

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
