

## bason 3537 # Expanded Dictionary Study

bason 3537 # nipter {nip-tare'}; from 3538; a ewer: -- {bason}.

unwashen 0449 # aniptos {an'-ip-tos}; from 1 (as a negative particle) and a presumed derivative of 3538; without ablution: -- {unwashen}. [q]

wash 0633 # aponipto {ap-on-ip'-to}; from 575 and 3538; to wash off (reflexively, one's own hands symbolically): -- {wash}.

wash 3068 # louo {loo'-o}; a primary verb; to bathe (the whole person; whereas 3538 means to wet a part only, and 4150 to wash, cleanse garments exclusively): -- {wash}. [q]

wash 3538 # nipto {nip'-to}; to cleanse (especially the hands or the feet or the face); ceremonially, to perform ablution: -- {wash}. Compare 3068. [q]

wash 4150 # pluno {ploo'-no}; a prolonged form of an obsolete pluo (to "flow"); to "plunge", i.e. launder clothing: -- {wash}. Compare 3068, 3538. [q]

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
