all 1273 # dianuktereuo {dee-an-ook-ter-yoo' -o}; from 1223 and a derivative of 3571; to sit up the whole night: -- continue {all} night. [q]

and 3574 # nuchthemeron {nookh-thay' -mer-on}; from 3571 and 2250; a day-and-night, i.e. full day of twenty-four hours: -- night {and} day. [q]

before 1773 # ennuchon {en' -noo-khon}; neuter of a compound of 1722 and 3571; (adverbially) by night: -- {before} day. [q]

continue 1273 # dianuktereuo {dee-an-ook-ter-yoo' -o}; from 1223 and a derivative of 3571; to sit up the whole night: -- {continue} all night. [q]

day 1773 # ennuchon {en' -noo-khon}; neuter of a compound of 1722 and 3571; (adverbially) by night: -- before {day}. [q]

day 3574 # nuchthemeron {nookh-thay' -mer-on}; from 3571 and 2250; a day-and-night, i.e. full day of twenty-four hours: -- night and {day}. [q]

following 1966 # epiouosa {ep-ee-oo' -sah}; feminine singular participle of a comparative of 1909 and heimi (to go); supervening, i.e. (2250 or 3571 being expressed or implied) the ensuing day or night: -- {following}, next. [q]

mid-)night 3571 # nux {noox}; a primary word; "night" (literally or figuratively): -- ({mid-)night}. [q]

midnight 3317 # mesonukti on {mes-on-ook' -tee-on}; neuter of compound of 3319 and 3571; midnight (specifically as a watch): -- {midnight}. [q]

next 1966 # epiouosa {ep-ee-oo' -sah}; feminine singular participle of a comparative of 1909 and heimi (to go); supervening, i.e. (2250 or 3571 being expressed or implied) the ensuing day or night: -- following, {next}. [q]
