odour 3744 # osme {os-may'}; from 3605; fragrance (literally or figuratively): -- {odour}, savour. [q]

savour 2175 # euodia {yoo-o-dee' -ah}; from a compound of 2095 and a derivative of 3605; good-scentedness, i.e. fragrance: -- sweet {savour} (smell, -smelling). [q]

savour 3744 # osme {os-may'}; from 3605; fragrance (literally or figuratively): -- odour, {savour}. [q]
