

## sail 4126 # Expanded Dictionary Study

sail 4126 # pleo {pleh'-o}; another form for pleuo {plyoo'-o}; which is used as an alternate in certain tenses; probably a form of 4150 (through the idea of plunging through the water); to pass in a vessel: -- {sail}. See also 4130. [q]

wash 0637 # apopluno {ap-op-loo'-no}; from 575 and 4150; to rinse off: -- {wash}. [q]

wash 3068 # louo {loo'-o}; a primary verb; to bathe (the whole person; whereas 3538 means to wet a part only, and 4150 to wash, cleanse garments exclusively): -- {wash}. [q]

wash 4150 # pluno {plooo'-no}; a prolonged form of an obsolete pluo (to "flow"); to "plunge", i.e. launder clothing: -- {wash}. Compare 3068, 3538. [q]

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
