have 4380 # prosopolepteo {pros-o-pol-ape-teh'-o}; from 4381; to favor an individual, i.e. show partiality: -- {have} respect to persons. [q]

of 0678 # aprosopoleptos {ap-ros-o-pol-ape'-tos}; adverb from a compound of 1 (as a negative particle) and a presumed derivative of a presumed compound of 4383 and 2983 [compare 4381]; in a way not accepting the person, i.e. impartially: -- without respect {of} persons. [q]

of 4381 # prosopoleptes {pros-o-pol-ape'-tace}; from 4383 and 2983; an accepter of a face (individual), i.e. (specifically) one exhibiting partiality: -- respecter {of} persons. [q]

of 4382 # prosopolepsia {pros-o-pol-ape-see'-ah}; from 4381; partiality, i.e. favoritism: -- respect {of} persons. [q]

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
