fight 4438 # pukteo {pook-teh' -o}; from a derivative of the same as 4435; to box (with the fist), i.e. contend (as a boxer) at the games (figuratively): -- {fight}. [q]

oft 4435 # pugme {poog-may' }; from a primary pux (the fist as a weapon); the clenched hand, i.e. (only in dative case as adverb) with the fist (hard scrubbing): -- {oft}. [q]

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
