needle 4476 # rhapsis {hraf-ece'}; from a primary rhapto (to sew; perhaps rather akin to the base of 4474 through the idea of puncturing); a needle: -- {needle}. [q]

on 1976 # epi rrhapto {ep-ir-hrap' -to}; from 1909 and the base of 4476; to stitch upon, i.e. fasten with the needle: -- sew {on}. [q]

seam 0729 # arrhaphos {ar' -hraf-os}; from 1 (as a negative particle) and a presumed derivative of the same as 4476; unsewed, i.e. of a single piece: -- without {seam}. [q]

sew 1976 # epi rrhapto {ep-ir-hrap' -to}; from 1909 and the base of 4476; to stitch upon, i.e. fasten with the needle: -- {sew} on. [q]

without 0729 # arrhaphos {ar' -hraf-os}; from 1 (as a negative particle) and a presumed derivative of the same as 4476; unsewed, i.e. of a single piece: -- {without} seam. [q]
