dig 2679 # kataskapto {kat-as-kap'-to}; from 2596 and 4626; to undermine, i.e. (by implication) destroy: -- {dig} down, ruin. [q]

dig 4626 # skapto {skap'-to}; apparently a primary verb; to dig: -- {dig}. [q]

down 2679 # kataskapto {kat-as-kap'-to}; from 2596 and 4626; to undermine, i.e. (by implication) destroy: -- dig {down}, ruin. [q]

mark 4649 # skopos {skop-os'} ("scope"); from skeptomai (to peer about ["skeptical"]; perhaps akin to 4626 through the idea of concealment; compare 4629); a watch (sentry or scout), i.e. (by implication) a goal: -- {mark}. [q]

ruin 2679 # kataskapto {kat-as-kap'-to}; from 2596 and 4626; to undermine, i.e. (by implication) destroy: -- dig down, {ruin}. [q]

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
