crooked 4646 # skolios {skol-ee-os'}; from the base of 4628; warped, i.e. winding; figuratively, perverse: -- {crooked}, froward, untoward. [q]

fierce 4642 # skleros {sklay-ros'}; from the base of 4628; dry, i.e. hard or tough (figuratively, harsh, severe): -- {fierce}, hard. [q]

froward 4646 # skolios {skol-ee-os'}; from the base of 4628; warped, i.e. winding; figuratively, perverse: -- crooked, {froward}, untoward. [q]

hard 4642 # skleros {sklay-ros'}; from the base of 4628; dry, i.e. hard or tough (figuratively, harsh, severe): -- fierce, {hard}. [q]

leg 4628 # skelos {skel'-os}; apparently from skello (to parch; through the idea of leanness); the leg (as lank): -- {leg}. [q]

thorn 4647 # skolops {skol'-ops}; perhaps from the base of 4628 and 3700; withered at the front, i.e. a point or prickle (figuratively, a bodily annoyance or disability): -- {thorn}. [q]

untoward 4646 # skolios {skol-ee-os'}; from the base of 4628; warped, i.e. winding; figuratively, perverse: -- crooked, froward, {untoward}. [q]

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
