habitation 4633 # skene {skay-nay'}; apparently akin to 4632 and 4639; a tent or cloth hut (literally or figuratively): -- {habitation}, tabernacle. [q]

tabernacle 4633 # skene {skay-nay'}; apparently akin to 4632 and 4639; a tent or cloth hut (literally or figuratively): -- habitation, {tabernacle}. [q]

tabernacle 4636 # skenos {skay'-nos}; from 4633; a hut or temporary residence, i.e. (figuratively) the human body (as the abode of the spirit): -- {tabernacle}. [q]

tent-maker 4635 # skenopios {skay-nop-oy-os'}; from 4633 and 4160; a manufacturer of tents: -- {tent-maker}. [q]
