devised 4679 # sophizo {sof-id'-zo}; from 4680; to render wise; in a sinister acceptation, to form "sophisms", i.e. continue plausible error: -- cunningly {devised}, make wise. [q]

fool 0781 # asophos {as'-of-os}; from 1 (as a negative particle) and 4680; unwise: -- {fool}. [q]

make 4679 # sophizo {sof-id'-zo}; from 4680; to render wise; in a sinister acceptation, to form "sophisms", i.e. continue plausible error: -- cunningly devised, {make} wise. [q]

philosopher 5386 # philosophos {fil-os'-of-os}; from 5384 and 4680; fond of wise things, i.e. a "philosopher": -- {philosopher}. [q]

wisdom 4678 # sophia {sof-ee'-ah}; from 4680; wisdom (higher or lower, worldly or spiritual): -- {wisdom}. [q]

wise 4679 # sophizo {sof-id'-zo}; from 4680; to render wise; in a sinister acceptation, to form "sophisms", i.e. continue plausible error: -- cunningly devised, make {wise}. [q]

wise 4680 # sophos {sof-os'}; akin to saphes (clear); wise (in a most general application): -- {wise}. Compare 5429. [q]

wise 5429 # phronimos {fron'-ee-mos}; from 5424; thoughtful, i.e. sagacious or discreet (implying a cautious character; while 4680 denotes practical skill or acumen; and 4908 indicates rather intelligence or mental acquirement); in a bad sense conceited (also in the comparative): -- {wise}(-r). [q]
