

churches 2417 # Expanded Dictionary Study

churches 2417 # hierosulos {hee-er-os'-oo-los}; from 2411 and 4813; a temple-despoiler: -- robber of {churches}. [q]

Mary 3137 # Maria {mar-ee'-ah}; or Mariam {mar-ee-am'}; of Hebrew origin [4813]; Maria or Mariam (i.e. Mirjam), the name of six Christian females: -- {Mary}. [q]

of 2417 # hierosulos {hee-er-os'-oo-los}; from 2411 and 4813; a temple-despoiler: -- robber {of} churches. [q]

rob 4813 # sulao {soo-lah'-o}; from a derivative of sullo (to strip; probably akin to 138; compare 4661); to despoil: -- {rob}. [q]

robber 2417 # hierosulos {hee-er-os'-oo-los}; from 2411 and 4813; a temple-despoiler: -- {robber} of churches. [q]

spoil 4812 # sulagoeo {soo-lag-ogue-eh'-o}; from the base of 4813 and (the reduplicated form of) 71; to lead away as booty, i.e. (figuratively) seduce: -- {spoil}. [q]

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
