

brass 5470 # Expanded Dictionary Study

brass 5470 # chalkeos {khal'-keh-os}; from 5475; coppery: -- {brass}. [q]

brass 5474 # chalkolibanon {khal-kol-ib'-an-on}; neuter of a compound of 5475 and 3030 (in the implied mean of whiteness or brilliancy); burnished copper, an alloy of copper (or gold) and silver having a brilliant lustre: -- fine {brass}. [q]

brass 5475 # chalkos {khal-kos'}; perhaps from 5465 through the idea of hollowing out as a vessel (this metal being chiefly used for that purpose); copper (the substance, or some implement or coin made of it): -- {brass}, money. [q]

brazen 5473 # chalkeion {khal-kee'-on}; diminutive from 5475; a copper dish: -- {brazen} vessel. [q]

chalcedony 5472 # chalcedon {khal-kay-dohn'}; from 5475 and perhaps 1491; copper-like, i. e. "chalcedony": -- {chalcedony}. [q]

coppersmith 5471 # chalkeus {khal-k-yooce'}; from 5475; a copper-worker or brazier: -- {coppersmith}. [q]

fine 5474 # chalkolibanon {khal-kol-ib'-an-on}; neuter of a compound of 5475 and 3030 (in the implied mean of whiteness or brilliancy); burnished copper, an alloy of copper (or gold) and silver having a brilliant lustre: -- {fine} brass. [q]

money 5475 # chalkos {khal-kos'}; perhaps from 5465 through the idea of hollowing out as a vessel (this metal being chiefly used for that purpose); copper (the substance, or some implement or coin made of it): -- brass, {money}. [q]

vessel 5473 # chalkeion {khal-kee'-on}; diminutive from 5475; a copper dish: -- brazen {vessel}. [q]
