foul 5494 # cheimon {khi -mone'}; from a derivative of cheo (to pour; akin to the base of 5490 through the idea of a channel), meaning a storm (as pouring rain); by implication, the rainy season, i.e. winter: -- tempest, {foul} weather, winter. [q]

ground 5476 # chamai {kham -ah' -ee}; adverb perhaps from the base of 5490 through the idea of a fissure in the soil; earthward, i.e. prostrate: -- on (to) the {ground}. [q]

ground 5561 # chora {kho' -rah}; feminine of a derivative of the base of 5490 through the idea of empty expanse; room, i.e. a space of territory (more or less extensive; often including its inhabitants): -- coast, county, fields, {ground}, land, region. Compare 5117. [q]

lip 5491 # cheilos {khi' -los}; from a form of the same as 5490; a lip (as a pouring place); figuratively, a margin (of water): -- {lip}, shore. [q]

on 5476 # chamai {kham -ah' -ee}; adverb perhaps from the base of 5490 through the idea of a fissure in the soil; earthward, i.e. prostrate: -- {on} (to) the ground. [q]

tempest 5494 # cheimon {khi -mone'}; from a derivative of cheo (to pour; akin to the base of 5490 through the idea of a channel), meaning a storm (as pouring rain); by implication, the rainy season, i.e. winter: -- {tempest}, foul weather, winter. [q]

the 5476 # chamai {kham -ah' -ee}; adverb perhaps from the base of 5490 through the idea of a fissure in the soil; earthward, i.e. prostrate: -- on (to) {the} ground. [q]

widow 5503 # chera {khay' -rah}; feminine of a presumed derivative apparently from the base of 5490 through the idea of deficiency; a widow (as lacking a husband), literally or figuratively: -- {widow}. [q]

winter 5494 # cheimon {khi -mone'}; from a derivative of cheo (to pour; akin to the base of 5490 through the idea of a channel), meaning a storm (as pouring rain); by implication, the rainy season, i.e. winter: -- tempest, foul weather, {winter}. [q]
