false 5571 # pseudes {psyoo-dace'}; from 5574; untrue, i.e. erroneous, deceitful, wicked: -- {false}, liar. [q]

falsely 5574 # pseudomai {psyoo'-dom-ahee}; middle voice of an apparently primary verb; to utter an untruth or attempt to deceive by falsehood: -- {falsely}, lie. [q]

liar 5571 # pseudes {psyoo-dace'}; from 5574; untrue, i.e. erroneous, deceitful, wicked: -- false, {liar}. [q]

liar 5583 # pseustes {psyoos-tace'}; from 5574; a falsifier: -- {liar}. [q]

lie 5574 # pseudomai {psyoo'-dom-ahee}; middle voice of an apparently primary verb; to utter an untruth or attempt to deceive by falsehood: -- falsely, {lie}. [q]

lie 5579 # pseudos {psyoo'-dos}; from 5574; a falsehood: -- {lie}, lying. [q]

lie 5582 # pseusma {psyoos'-mah}; from 5574; a fabrication, i.e. falsehood: -- {lie}. [q]

lying 5579 # pseudos {psyoo'-dos}; from 5574; a falsehood: -- lie, {lying}. [q]

whispering 5587 # psithurismos {psith-oo-ris-mos'}; from a derivative of psithos (a whisper; by implication, a slander; probably akin to 5574); whispering, i.e. secret detraction: -- {whispering}. [q]

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
