Emmor 1697 # Emmor {em-mor'}; of Hebrew origin [2544]; Emmor (i.e. Chamor), a Canaanite: -- {Emmor}. [q]

nevertheless 2544 # kai toige {kah'-ee-toyg-eh}; from 2543 and 1065; and yet indeed, i.e. although really: -- {nevertheless}, though. [q]

there 5105 # toigaroun {toy-gar-oon'}; from 5104 and 1063 and 3767; truly for then, i.e. consequently: -- {there-}(where-)fore. [q] ***. toige. See 2544. [q]
