

dog 2952 # Expanded Dictionary Study

dog 2952 # kunarion {koo-nar' -ee-on}; neuter of a presumed derivative of 2965; a young puppy; -- {dog}. [q]

dog 2965 # kuon {koo' -ohn}; a primary word; a dog ["hound"] (literally or figuratively): -- {dog}. [q]

dung 4657 # skubalon {skoo' -bal -on}; neuter of a presumed derivative of 1519 and 2965 and 906; what is thrown to the dogs, i.e. refuse (ordure): -- {dung}. [q]

worship 4352 # proskuneo {pros-koo-neh' -o}; from 4314 and a probable derivative of 2965 (meaning to kiss, like a dog licking his master's hand); to fawn or crouch to, i.e. (literally or figuratively) prostrate oneself in homage (do reverence to, adore): -- {worship}. [q]

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
