cannot 3467 # muopazo {moo-ope-ad' -zo}; from a compound of the base of 3466 and ops (the face; from 3700); to shut the eyes, i. e. blink (see indistinctly): -- {cannot} see far off. [q]

close 2576 # kammuo {kam-moo' -o}; from a compound of 2596 and the base of 3466; to shut down, i. e. close the eyes: -- {close}. [q]

far 3467 # muopazo {moo-ope-ad' -zo}; from a compound of the base of 3466 and ops (the face; from 3700); to shut the eyes, i. e. blink (see indistinctly): -- cannot see {far} off. [q]

fool 3474 # moros {mo-ros' }; probably from the base of 3466; dull or stupid (as if shut up), i. e. heedless, (morally) blockhead, (apparently) absurd: -- {fool}(-ish, X -ishness). [q]

instruct 3453 # muevo {moo-eh' -o}; from the base of 3466; to initiate, i. e. (by implication) to teach: -- {instruct}. [q]

mystery 3466 # musterion {moos-tay' -ree-on}; from a derivative of muo (to shut the mouth); a secret or "mystery" (through the idea of silence imposed by initiation into religious rites): -- {mystery}. [q]

off 3467 # muopazo {moo-ope-ad' -zo}; from a compound of the base of 3466 and ops (the face; from 3700); to shut the eyes, i. e. blink (see indistinctly): -- cannot see far {off}. [q]
