

Issachar 2466 # Expanded Dictionary Study

Issachar 2466 # Isachar {ee-sakh-ar'}; of Hebrew origin [3485]; Isachar (i.e. Jissaskar), a son of Jacob (figuratively, his descendant): -- {Issachar}. [q]

shrine 3485 # naos {nah-os'}; from a primary naio (to dwell); a fane, shrine, temple : -- {shrine}, temple. Comp 2411. [q]

temple 2411 # hieron {hee-er-on'}; neuter of 2413; a sacred place, i.e. the entire precincts (whereas 3485 denotes the central sanctuary itself) of the Temple (at Jerusalem or elsewhere): -- {temple}. [q]

temple 3485 # naos {nah-os'}; from a primary naio (to dwell); a fane, shrine, temple : -- shrine, {temple}. Comp 2411. [q]

worshipper 3511 # neokoros {neh-o-kor'-os}; from a form of 3485 and koreo (to sweep); a temple-servant, i.e. (by implication) a votary: -- {worshipper}. [q]

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
